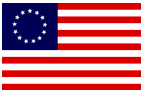

Kim Kline’s Old-Fashioned Soft Pumpkin Cookies

| 1 tsp baking soda | 1/2 cup butter (1 stick), softened | Glaze |
| 1 tsp baking powder | 1 cup Pure Pumpkin | 2 cups sifted powdered sugar |
| 1 tsp ground cinnamon | 1 large egg | 3 tbsp milk |
| 1/2 tsp ground nutmeg | 1 tsp vanilla extract | 1 tbsp. melted butter |
| 1/2 teaspoon salt | | 1 tsp vanilla extract |
| 1 1/2 cups granulated sugar | | |

Preheat oven to 350° F. Grease baking sheets. Combine flour, baking soda, baking powder, cinnamon, nutmeg and salt in medium bowl. Beat sugar and butter in large mixer bowl until well blended. Beat in pumpkin, egg and vanilla extract until smooth. Gradually beat in flour mixture. Drop by rounded tablespoon onto prepared baking sheets. Bake for 15 to 18 minutes or until edges are firm. Cool on baking sheets for 2 minutes; remove to wire racks to cool completely.

For Glaze: Stir glaze ingredients in small bowl until smooth. Drizzle Glaze over cookies.

THANKSGIVING IN AMERICA: CELEBRATED SINCE ... 1619?

Along the James River in Virginia, the Berkeley Hundred colony held a religious service on December 4, 1619, to give thanks for "the day of our ship's arrival" and proclaimed the date would be "yearly and perpetually kept holy as a day of thanksgiving to the Almighty God. However in 1622, after nine of the colonists were killed by Powhatan Indians, the colony was abandoned. Had this group not departed, they would probably be known as the originators of the Thanksgiving holiday, rather than the Pilgrims of the Plymouth colony.

The Final Authority

Somebody says, “Well, we have different kinds of churches. You have a soul-winning church, and we have a deeper-life church.” In the first place, it’s a lie. There’s no life as deep as a soul-winning life. However, they say, “We just have different kinds of churches.” No, we don’t. We have a church, and you don’t! Brother, the Bible is our charter to exist. If the Bible is not your final authority in practice and doctrine, then you are not a church. You might have the word “church” on the outside, but you are not a church.

Since the Word of God is our authority, —hear me carefully— we simply must have it. That’s a profound statement. We’ve got to have it! I mean, shall we have an authority we can’t find? Would God tell us His Word is the final authority and leave us without His Word? We must have a copy or we may as well join our Catholic friends and let the church be the basis for truth. If we have no Word of God, and if the Bible is not the Word of God, then we have only three other alternatives. We’ve got to say the final authority will be the church, or human experience, or human reasoning.

I’m saying, if we have no Bible that is the Word of God, then we have no way to go to the Book for the final authority. If one word in this Bible is not true, we don’t know which one it is; so, once again, the mind of man or experience or the church is going to have to decide which one is true and which one is not true. If we are going to believe that the Word of God is the final authority, we’ve got to have a copy of it.

Let me ask you a question. Would God call a man to preach His Word and not give it to him?

The Real Rambo

Otero-Barreto returned home from Vietnam on Dec. 15, 1970. It was not pleasant. “When I came back from Vietnam, nobody wanted us. Nobody. They were hating us.”

He remembers being spit on by protesters and people “looking at me like I was a monkey.”

Even so, he didn’t react or fight back. “I kept complete control,” he recalls. “When I was in the jungle, I didn’t fight the enemy when they wanted to fight me. I fought them when I wanted to fight them. The same principle applied.”

At home, Otero-Barreto reunited with his young wife and baby. Inside, his demons raged.

“I wasn’t happy,” he says. “I was sad. I was thinking that the U.S. Army in Vietnam was my family. I put the U.S. Army before my family. I felt like a coward because I quit. I was a warrior and a warrior never quits. Christmas Day, Santa Claus, blah blah blah. I felt paralyzed. I lost my mind.”

Otero-Barreto checked into a hospital, where doctors diagnosed him with combat fatigue -the Vietnam-era term for post-traumatic stress. He spent 15 days in the facility.

“I was hating my neighbors,” he says. “I was hating the U.S. Army. I was hating my family. I was hating myself. I was a warrior hating everybody. I was feeling guilty. My wife told me that if I didn’t quit the Army mindset we were through. I was hating everybody for seven years, and it wasn’t their fault. It was me.”

At one point, Otero-Barreto took his medals to the downtown market. He asked a vendor for a coffee and offered one of his medals instead of the \$1 price. The vendor refused. Believing the medals were worthless, Otero-Barreto threw all of them away. Fortunately, a neighbor collected them from the trash. Jorge did five tours in Vietnam, engaged in more than 350 combat and aerial missions and was wounded five times - is among the most decorated Vietnam War veterans, with more than 40 military honors that include multiple Silver Stars and five Purple Hearts.

His exploits on the battlefield earned him adulation from his troops and the nickname, “Puerto Rican Rambo.”

“I want to be remembered as a good father. He bows his head and pauses. “A good grandpa, and a good husband. And that’s how I want them to remember me.”

Homosexual Indoctrination Forced on Young Kids

LGBT-friendly instruction is being brought to increasingly younger students. In California, a 2011 law required that LGBT content be included in social studies and history curriculum. The new material is being introduced to students as young as second graders this fall. In Washington state, students beginning in kindergarten will be taught about "the many ways to express gender" starting in fall of 2017.

"Small states don't have the option of customizing their textbooks; they have to choose what the big states choose," says Brad Dacus of Pacific Justice Institute. "So this will impact school districts in other states around the country."

Meanwhile, where gender studies are not mandated in the classroom, a web series called "Queer Kids Stuff" is intended to reach preschool audiences.

Second Man Caught Videotaping Women Undressing at Target Stores

The American Family Association is praising Texas Attorney General Ken Paxton for urging Target to re-examine its controversial trans-gender bathroom policies after a second man was caught recording women undressing in changing rooms.

"After this latest incident, I hope Target finally recognizes the importance of protecting its customers, especially in environments where they can be at their most vulnerable. I am offering them the resources of my office to help assist them in improving their safety procedures," Paxton said in a message to Target...

Paxton was referring to police reports searching for a man who peered over a changing room wall with a cellphone at a Target store on Northwest Highway at Abrams. It is the second such incident reported, after a similar crime occurred back in May at a Target store in Frisco, Texas.

The majority of the credit for making the annual Thanksgiving holiday a national holiday goes to Sarah Josepha Hale. She was the editor of Ladies Magazine and Godey's Lady's Book. In 1827 she began to advocate for Thanksgiving by printing articles in the magazines. She also published stories and recipes, and wrote letters to governors, senators, and presidents. It took her 36 years to persuade the President and Congress to her point of view. On October 3, 1863, supported by the Union victory at Gettysburg, President Lincoln proclaimed November 26 a national day of Thanksgiving, to be observed every year on the fourth Thursday of November.

On October 3, 1789, President George Washington issued a proclamation directing Americans to celebrate and give thanks on Thursday, November 26.

"Now, therefore, I do recommend and assign Thursday, the 26th day of November next, to be devoted by the people of these States to the service of that great and glorious Being who is the beneficent author of all the good that was, that is, or that will be; that we may then all unite in rendering unto Him our sincere and humble thanks for His kind care and protection of the people of this country previous to their becoming a nation; for the signal and manifold mercies and the favor, able interpositions of His providence in the course and conclusion of the late war; for the great degree of tranquilly, union, and plenty which we have since enjoyed; for the peaceable and rational manner in which we have been enabled to establish constitutions of government for our safety and happiness, and particularly the national one now lately instituted; for the civil and religious liberty with which we are blessed, and the means we have of acquiring and diffusing useful knowledge; and, in general, for all the great and various favors which He has been pleased to confer upon us."
