## The Opportunities of a New Year

In *Luke 19:41-44*, we find Christ weeping over the city of Jerusalem. Why was Christ weeping? Because they had missed the opportunity that God had given them.

“*And when he was come near, he beheld the city, and wept over it.*” With the new year upon us, we still must understand the

need of recognizing and grabbing hold of the opportunities presented to us.

### FIRST: THE URGENCY OF OPPORTUNITY.

MARK 10:46-52

In *Mark 10:46*, “*And they came to Jericho...*,” we find that this was the last time Jesus passed through this city. If blind Bartimaeus would not have continued to cry out, “*Thou son of David, have mercy on me,*” he would not have received his sight, nor would he have had his sins forgiven.

The privilege of sharing the Gospel is offered.

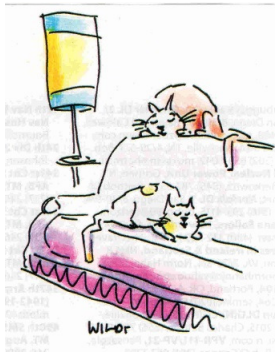
“*Zacchaeus, make hast, and come down; for today I must abide in thy house.*”

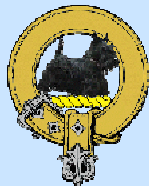

#### Lest We Forget

Continental Congress July 8, 1776, for the first time read the Declaration of Independence publicly, as the famous "Liberty Bell" was rung. Congress then established a three-man committee, consisting of Thomas Jefferson, John Adams and Benjamin Franklin, for the purpose of designing a great seal for the United States.

Benjamin Franklin's suggestions for a seal and motto, characterizing the spirit of this new nation, were:

*Moses lifting up his wand, and dividing the Red Sea, and Pharaoh in his chariot overwhelmed with the waters. This motto: "Rebellion to tyrants is obedience to God."*

Thomas Jefferson proposed:

**THIRD: THE ULTIMATE DANGER OF OPPORTUNITY.**

**LUKE 19:42-43**

That danger is to know you have it but you choose to ignore it. The ultimate danger is the judgment of God.

*“For the days shall come upon thee...”*

I have noticed three main reasons for opportunities missed:

1. Too distracted by the practice of sin.
2. Too busy to be bothered by the eternal.
3. Too lazy to find out if there is an opportunity.

We must take time to examine the opportunities that God has offered us before it is too late.

*“Now is the accepted time...now is the day of salvation.” II Corinthians 6:2.*

**Conclusion:** I could also add to the list, “Too discouraged.” Many of a wonderful opportunity has been missed by those too discouraged to see any light at the end of the tunnel.

*Illustration:* The other day I read of the strangest court-martial in recorded military history. The man being court-martialed was not carrying information to the enemy. The soldier was not disloyal to America. What was the charge against him in World War II? He was charged as a discourager. That’s right. He was so critical of everything and everyone in his company that he was discouraging the troops all the time. He was found guilty and sentenced to one year in a military prison. The charge, “using words that weakened the nation with a critical attitude.”

**Luke 11:52, “Ye entered not in yourselves, and them that were entering in ye hindered.”**

What will you do with the opportunities given you in the new year?

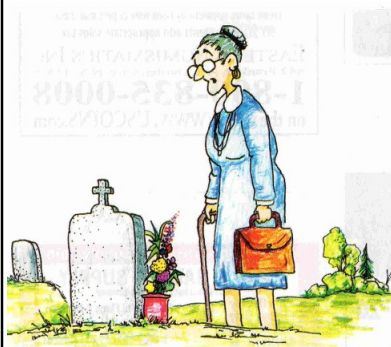

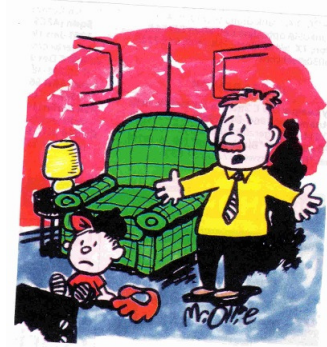
**My Preacher**

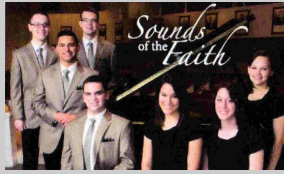

## Dangerous Beauties

The Bible invests a great deal of space warning men about a dangerous category of women called "strange women." Now it is my belief that these women must have been attractive, but I can't prove that. I can only say with Scriptural authority that their allure was powerful and that they knew how to look, what to say and what to do to draw a man into the net. Let's look at three basic categories of these "strange women":

**1. The Adulteress.** This woman is married or will take a married man from his wife. She knows how to say the right thing to flatter a man, and she has a feminine mystique that is very seductive. This woman is described in **Proverbs 5:3-6**, and we would be wise to warn our sons to beware of this type of woman! We must also pray for the protection of our husbands against the snares of the strange woman, as she could be sitting in the next cubicle at his workplace! This woman is very strategic in her goal of trapping a married man, and she is without moral compass.

**2. The Evil Woman.** This woman is very similar to the adulteress (they can actually be interchangeable), and she too uses flattery as a tool. We must never underestimate the power of the tongue when it comes to either drawing or repulsing a man! Although we cannot be held accountable for a man's wandering from the nest and into the arms of another woman, we certainly can do our best not to push him there! Many a man yearns for a kind and encouraging word from his wife. Imagine a starving man. Stale bread will taste good to someone who hasn't eaten in days. So it is with flattery to the ears of a loved-starved man. If he doesn't hear it from his wife, the enemy will insert the evil woman to trap him like an insect in a spider web of flattery. The evil woman has the advantage of beauty (vs. 25), and she also knows how to use her eyes to snare a man. She is stimulating, suggestive and always on the prowl (vs. 26).

**3. The Harlot.** This woman is easier to spot, because her clothing betrays her and her speech is "loud" (**Proverbs 7:11**). This type of woman is not as much of a threat to a man who stays busy and is in the right place, especially in His walk with the Lord. The harlot has a special area that she works, and a godly man would not likely cross her path. The Bible describes this woman as one who hunts for men on the streets (vs. 12). This woman is a prostitute and is very bold about it. She is only dangerous to those who are seeking her company. A man has to be morally unstable to want the company of a harlot. Still, we wives need to be sure that we are not providing a breeding ground for discontent in our men by being frequently angry or contentious. Harlots dwell in the "wilderness" of life, and a man who lives with an angry and contentious woman can be driven to that very same wilderness (**Proverbs 21:19**).

### Mrs. Collingsworth's Cinnamon Muffins

- |                          |                                    |                          |
|--------------------------|------------------------------------|--------------------------|
| 1 cup all-purpose flour  | 1 egg                              | <b>CRUMB TOPPING:</b>    |
| 1/3 cup sugar            | 1/3 cup milk                       | 4 tsp. all-purpose flour |
| 1 tsp. baking powder     | 1/4 cup butter, melted             | 2 tsp. sugar             |
| 1/4 tsp. salt            | 1-1/4 tsp. instant espresso powder | Pinch ground cinnamon    |
| 1/4 tsp. ground cinnamon |                                    | 2 tsp. cold butter       |

In a small bowl, combine the first five ingredients. Whisk the egg, milk, butter and espresso powder until espresso powder is dissolved. Stir into the dry ingredients just until moistened. Fill greased or paper-lined muffin cups two-thirds full.

For topping, combine the flour, sugar and cinnamon. Cut in butter until mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Sprinkle about 1 tsp. over each muffin. Bake at 400° for 18-20 minutes or until a toothpick comes out clean. Cool for 5 minutes before removing to a wire rack. Serve warm. Yield: 6 muffins.

### **Maryland School Board Purges Christmas From Schedule**

Christmas has officially been cancelled in Montgomery County, Maryland, thanks to some not-so-wise men in charge of the local schedule. ### **School Shooting Used As Excuse To Restrict Homeschooling**

The Sandy Hook Advisory Commission, created by Governor Dannel P. Malloy in the aftermath of the school shooting in Newton, CT, claims that the Sandy Hook massacre occurred because Adam Lanza was homeschooled and his emotional problems went undetected. The commission recommends that homeschool students undergo mandatory mental health examinations to determine if they have emotional problems.

Dee Black with the Home School Legal Defense Association says Lanza was really a public school student studying at home. Although Lanza's mother pulled him out of the classroom, he earned a degree from Newtown High School, an option not available to any homeschooled student.

"When you look at the instances where we've had these tragedies in other public schools, they've always been committed by public school students. And in fact we know that Adam Lanza was at least somewhat a product of the public school system" the attorney says.

Black says reports that Lanza was homeschooled presented an opportunity for homeschool opponents to try to place restrictions on homeschooling.

Per the commission's plan, homeschool students identified as having emotional or behavioral problems would be required to follow an education plan approved by the public school district. If subsequent progress reports showed inadequate results, the right to homeschool would be denied.
