Have You Grown?

<u>Introduction:</u> Let me ask you a question: If I were to approach each of you and ask, "Have you grown spiritually?" What would your answer be? Would it be a positive "Yes." Why? Because we are commanded to grow spiritually. II Peter 3:18, "But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ."

If you have been here for any length of time, then you know that the seed has been planted. The question is, "Have you grown?"

FIRST: HAVE YOU GROWN IN THE SCRIPTURES?

I PETER 2:2

"As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby."

Can you say that you have honestly opened the Word of God every day and read from its wonderful pages? Can you?

God compares a new Christian with a newborn baby. You always feed a new baby, "sincere" or "pure" milk. That is why you had better make sure you are feeding from the right Bible. The one that has been proven by time to be loved by the faithful yet despised by the disobedient.

You will find that the Word of God teaches that if you are growing spiritually, then you should be going from milk to meat. (*I Corinthians 3:2*)

Illustration: It ought to be obvious to anyone that if a full grown person is still drinking from a bottle with a nipple on it, there is a problem.

SECOND: HAVE YOU GROWN IN SERVICE?

COLOSSIANS 3:23-24

"And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord...For ye serve the Lord Christ."

I have known professing Christians that have been members of a church for 40 years, yet never taught a Sunday school class, worked on a bus route, or even offered to clean the church, or mow the grass. What a shame!

Illustration: When Saul of Tarsus placed his faith in Jesus Christ, he

How many letters in the word Saviour? Seven, S-A-V-I-O-U-R, seven, that is our Saviour. Here it is in the NIV,

"I want you to recall the words spoken in the past by the holy prophets and the command given by our Lord and Savior through your apostles."

Six letters! Through your apostles, the six-letter savior is Antichrist. The New Age movement has set him up as Antichrist. In Helena Blavatsky's book, she speaks of her savior, her coming one with six

letters, that is Antichrist. When she speaks of the Christian Saviour, she spells it with seven letters because she does not want Him to have it spelled with six like her savior. And yet, all the perversions have messed this up, but especially the NIV, which is Antichrist's bible. Now over and over, it is taking away His Deity, saying He is not God. If Jesus is not God, you and I have a make-believe Saviour and a make-believe salvation.

Let me tell you this about the NIV. The NIV removed the title "Lord" from Jesus thirty-one times in the New Testament. The name "Christ" was removed fortyfive times in the NIV when compared with the King James. The name "Jesus" was removed forty-six times in the NIV. It is Antichrist's bible.

THIRD: HAVE YOU GROWN IN STANDARDS?

JAMES 1:22

"But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves."

By standards, I mean the rules that you measure your course by, that reveal the conditions that control your life.

I. Your loyalty to truth. John 17:17, "Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth."

In John 14:6, "Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth..."

To be loyal to truth is to be loyal to both our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ and to the Word of God.

What is the standard of your loyalty?

II. Your Love for Modesty? *I Timothy 2:9*

"In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel."

The word "modest" is connected to "apparel" in this verse. It means that there are to be standards that are different for the child of God that the world does not see, nor understand.

A Christian lady should never wear clothing that deliberately draws attention to her thighs or her breast.

FOURTH: HAVE YOU GROWN IN DESIRE TO REACH LOST SOULS?

LUKE 19:10

"For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost."

The heartbeat of Christ is to save the lost. The reason for Calvary was for Christ to shed His blood as full payment for our sin.

If the greatest concern of our Saviour was for the souls of the lost, then it should be of great concern to the one who says they have received Christ as their Saviour.

If Christ can save me, then it should be obvious that He can save others.

FIFTH: HAVE YOU GROWN IN LOVE WITH THE SAVIOUR?

JOHN 14:15

"If ye love me, keep my commandments."

Nothing reveals your love for the Saviour like submission to His Word.

Illustration: When Jesus appeared to Peter at the sea of Tiberius, He asked him the most convicting question, "Simon, Son of Jonas, lovest thou me more than these?"

Have you ever heard anyone say, "To know Him is to love Him?"

<u>CONCLUSION:</u> My dad used to say to me as a little boy on the family farm, "Son, if it's not growing, it's dying." Christian, fellow church member, if you're not growing, you're dying. What are you willing to do about it?

Dangers Of Gun Control

This is from a report that was released by the Jews for the Preservation of Firearms Ownership (JPFO). It chronicles the relationship between gun restriction and confiscation and the genocide that took place following. Here is the record. It speaks for itself.

- The Soviet Union established gun control in 1929. From 1929 to 1953, 20 million political dissidents, unable to defend themselves, were rounded up and exterminated.
- Turkey established gun control in 1911. From 1915 to 1917, 1.5 million Armenians, unable to defend themselves, were rounded up and exterminated.
- China established gun control in 1935. From 1948 to 1976, 20 million Anti-Communists, Christians, political dissidents and pro-reform groups, unable to defend themselves, were rounded up and exterminated.
- Germany established gun control in 1938. From 1939 to 1945, 13 million Jews, Gypsies, mentally ill people and other "mongrelized peoples," unable to defend themselves, were rounded up and exterminated.
- Guatemala established gun control in 1964. From 1964 to 1981, 100,000
 Mayan Indians, unable to defend themselves, were rounded up and
 exterminated.
- Uganda established gun control in 1970. From 1971 to 1979, 300,000 Christians, unable to defend themselves, were rounded up and exterminated.
- Cambodia established gun control in 1956. From 1975 to 1977, 1 million "educated people," unable to defend themselves, were rounded up and executed.

If you were adding them up, that amounts to more than 55 million innocent people who were slaughtered by their own governments - governments that had first rendered their citizens defenseless by restricting or confiscating their firearms.

During the American Revolution, Lafayette served as a major general in the Continental Army under George Washington.

James Monroe, 18

A lieutenant in Washington's army, Monroe would grow up to become the fifth U.S. president and the last Founding Father to serve as chief executive.

Aaron Burr, 20

An officer in the Continental Army, Burr eventually served as the memorable third vice president of the United States.

Alexander Hamilton, 22

Appointed chief of staff to General Washington, Hamilton became one of the most influential promoters of the Constitution and the founder of the first American political party.

James Madison, 25

Madison would prove to be instrumental in the drafting of the Constitution and the writing of the Bill of Rights. He ultimately became the fourth U.S. president.

Kim Kline's Cabbage & Noodles with Bacon

1 head of cabbage

1 pound bacon

1 large onion

1 bag egg noodles

In a large skillet over medium-high heat, cook the bacon until crisp.

Remove from the pan and drain on paper towels, then break into bite-sized pieces. Meanwhile, bring a large pot of salted water to boil for the egg noodles.

Add the noodles and cook until done. Drain the noodles and set aside.

Drain some of the bacon fat from the pan, reserving enough to cook the onions. Add the chopped onion to the pan and cook for about 1-2 minutes, or until the onions begin to soften.

Add the cabbage to the skillet and cook until tender, stirring occasionally.

When the cabbage is tender, add the egg noodles and bacon, mixing thoroughly. Season with pepper. Serve immediately.
