Introduction: This is one of the greatest events ever recorded in history. I doubt that there was ever a battle fought that was so far reaching in its influence as the influence of this mother upon her son. *Exodus 2:9–10, "Take this child away and nurse it for me, and I will give thee thy wages ... and the child grew ... and she called his name Moses."*

Point to make: Abortion, the death of all newly born Hebrew boys, was commanded by Pharaoh. One woman, the mother of Moses,

believed that the only way to save her child was by doing exactly what God wanted her to do. She made a small craft with one opening and placed Moses in the Nile river. It floated down to where a royal princess was bathing in the water. When the child cried, her heart was opened, and decided to keep the child from harm. One problem: no nurse! Now God put the princess in contact with, of all people, Moses' mother. She places the child in the mother's care, and without knowing it, pays the mother to take care of her own child! This child would then lead hundreds of thousands of Hebrew slaves into freedom.

When God wants to train a child to achieve great things for Himself, He always sends him to be schooled by a godly mother. What were the characteristics of the woman who would raise the man that would shake the world?

FIRST: SHE WAS A WILLING MOTHER.

PROVERBS 22:6

Whatever else would come into this woman's life, there was nothing she thought more important than raising and training this child to be of service to God. I know that there are many women out there today that do not believe that motherhood is the greatest privilege ever given to a woman, but God declares that it is. There are even some that think that being a mother is more of a prison that robs them of their freedom to enjoy this old world. Not the mother of Moses. She looked upon this as an honor to be part of this child's future.

SECOND: SHE WAS A WOMAN OF FAITH.

II TIMOTHY 1:5

Hebrews 11:23, "By faith Moses, when he was born, was hid three months." This verse reveals that everything done by this mother was based upon her faith in the will of God.

Think with me. this woman lived in a day of extreme hatred toward God's people. It was a time of bitterness, darkness, yet here was a mother who raised a godly child that influence a nation. When God wanted to raise a man that would remake the world, He first had to place him under the influence of the right woman. But this was a work not accomplished because of the woman's high social standing, but because of her great faith.

THIRD: SHE WAS WISE IN HER CHOICE.

MATTHEW 6:33

The Blood Of Jesus



Turn, please, to Revelation 7:9-14, "After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands; And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb. And all the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces, and workinged Cod. Saving.

Nobody will ever get to Heaven who has not been washed in the blood of the Lamb. Nobody! It wasn't enough for Jesus to die for us. His blood had to be shed and applied!

I will say it again and again and again. They could have choked Him to death if dying was all He had to do, but there would have been no blood on the mercy seat. The blood atoned for our sins.

I love His body. It's wonderful, but at the Lord's Supper we take the broken body. Why the broken body first? Because that's the first thing—He died. Then what's next? The blood that was shed. That blood was applied, and without that blood applied, no death of a passover lamb was valid. Until that dead lamb's blood was applied on the doorposts, a curse of death was upon the firstborn in that home. The lamb had to die. You couldn't just take a little knife and stick the lamb and get some blood out of him. No, he had to die.

The death of Christ is necessary, but that isn't all that is necessary. He had to die and every drop of His blood had to be shed in order that you and I might have our sins atoned for. Even in the Revelation when the redeemed of the Lord wave their palm branches and sing, "Glory and honor and praise and blessing be unto the Lamb," and they give praise to Him and somebody says, "Who are these people shouting around here?" Does it say, "These are they which have washed their robes in the death of the lamb." No! It says, "These are they which ... have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb."

O, precious is the flow That makes me white as snow; No other fount I know. Nothing but the Blood of Jesus.

We had better thank God for the blood! Thank God for the blood! No wonder the apostles said, "By the precious blood of Jesus." Why precious? There is none like it. It's like the crown jewels. There are no others. Five quarts! That's all.

Preheat oven to 350 degrees . Grease and flour a 9xl3-inch baking dish.

Whisk cake mix, water, vegetable oil, and eggs together in a bowl until smooth; pour into the prepared baking dish.

Bake in the preheated oven until a toothpick inserted in the center of the cake comes out clean. 23 to 28 minutes.

Whisk cold milk and pudding mix together in a bowl until pudding is soft and thickened, about 2 minutes.

Poke holes into the cake using the handle of a clean wooden spoon. Pour pudding over cake, spreading evenly. Spread whipped topping over pudding layer and sprinkle vanilla wafers over whipped topping.
