The Way Back

<u>Introduction:</u> If there is anything America needs today more than revival, I do not know what that could be. We are a nation that has forgotten our Saviour and our God.

Illustration: I was reading of a man that visited America, who expressed our need more convincingly than most preachers that stand behind the pulpit. This dear visitor had traveled all over the world. He had asked question

after question in every nation. His observation of America? He said, "This is the only nation that I have toured that is ashamed of its religion."

Our forefathers were highly religious, and their religion was connected to Jesus Christ and Christianity. It is so obvious we are far from the faith of our fathers. The question is, "How do we get back to where we belong?"

I believe the answer can be found in the Bible. Let's examine a few revelations in the book of Il Chronicles. The principles for revival are the same today.

<u>Background:</u> Israel had dropped to a new low spiritually. They had embraced every wicked sin and every type of false god. A new king, Josiah, saw the way of revival. He wanted his nation to turn back to the God that had made their nation great. What did he do? Notice II Chronicles 34:29-33.

FIRST: THE SCRIPTURES WERE REINTRODUCED. II CHRONICLES 34:30

After the word of God was rediscovered in the house of God (for the Word was first lost in the house of God), Josiah personally read the Bible to others.

There will never be repentance, there will never be revival, until the Word of God is reintroduced. You see, real revival will never take place until there is a desire in a people to obey the Word of God. In every revival that I have ever read about, there was always found a reintroduction to God's Word.

Question: Just how much time do you spend in the Scriptures, and to what degree do you obey what you are discovering?

SECOND: THE STAND TAKEN.

George Washington

Father Of Our Country

"It is the duty of all nations to acknowledge the Providence of Almighty God, to obey His will, to be grateful for His benefits, and humbly implore His protection and favor."

John Jay

Father Of The Supreme Court

President of American Bible Society, 1821-28, and the first chief justice of the United States, 1789 -95. As Chief Justice, he wrote a decision that resulted in the eleventh Amendment to the U.S. Constitution and settled many disputes. Jay married Sarah Livingston on April 28, 1774 (died: May 28,1802), and they had seven children. Jay was admitted to the bar in 1768, served as a delegate to



the Continental Congress (1774-79), and was president of this Congress (1778-79). He was governor of New York, 1795-1801. Jay was in complete retirement after this.



William Carey

Father Of Modern Missions

"Father of Modern Missions" and missionary to India. Carey was a shoemaker 1775-89, school teacher, and Baptist pastor. He was converted on February 10, 1779, at a prayer service, following a witness from John Warr, a fellow cobbler. He then became a Baptist pastor in Moulton (1786) and Leicester(1790.) On October 2, 1792, he founded a Baptist Missionary Society in Kettering after

giving a historic sermon ("Enquiry...") on Isaiah 54:2-3, five months earlier. Carey sailed to India on June 13, 1793, and served there for 40 years until his death.

J. Frank Norris

Father Of The Independent Baptist Movement

President of World Baptist Fellowship, 1935-1952. Norris was the most fearless, powerful preacher of his generation. A Methodist, Norris was converted at a revival conducted by J. A. Oswalt at age 13. He was a student at Baylor University (1898-1902), married Lillian Gaddy on May 5,1902, then held a brief pastorate at McKinney Avenue Baptist Church in Dallas (1905-8) which grew from 100 to 1,000. Norris edited the Baptist Standard (1907-9). He pastored FBC, Ft. Worth, TX (1909-52), with 10,000



members and Temple Baptist Church, Detroit, MI (1935-51), with 8,000 members at the same time, traveling by air between the two cities. His assistants, Entzminger and Vick, were a big help. He opposed liberalism in the SBC, the liquor crowd, and evolutionists. He was expelled from the SBC in 1924. Norris edited Searchlight (1917-27) and the Fundamentalist (1927 on). He started World Baptist Fellowship (1935) and Bible Baptist Seminary, Fort Worth, TX (1939). In self-defense, he shot and killed a businessman, D. E. Chipps, on July 17, 1926, who entered his study threatening to kill him. Norris died of a heart attack while at a youth rally.

Kim Kline's Red White and Blueberry Pie



1-1/2 cups sugar 1/4 cup plus 1-1/2 teaspoons cornstarch 4 tablespoons plus 1-1/2 teaspoons raspberry gelatin 1-1/2 cups water
1 pint fresh or frozen
unsweetened blueberries
1 teaspoon lemon juice
1 pastry shell (9 inches),
baked

1 pint fresh or frozen unsweetened raspberries 4 ounces cream cheese, softened 1/3 cup confectioners' sugar 1-3/4 cups whipped topping

- 1. In a large saucepan, combine the sugar, cornstarch and water until smooth. Bring to a boil; cook and stir for 2 minutes or until thickened. Stir in gelatin until dissolved.
- 2. Divide mixture in half. Stir blueberries and lemon juice into one portion; spread over crust. Chill until set. Gently fold raspberries into remaining gelatin mixture; cool to room temperature and set aside.
- 3. Meanwhile, in a small bowl, beat cream cheese and confectioners' sugar until smooth. Fold in whipped topping; spread over blueberry layer. Chill until set, about 2 hours.
- 4. Carefully spread raspberry mixture over cream cheese layer. Chill for at least 4 hours.

You will find more than just words being spoken, but a stand being taken. If you tell me that you are right with God, then I expect a stand to be taken for or against sinful practices—drinking, idolatry, and a lack of love for the church should be rejected.

Illustration: In II Kings 23, Josiah stood against the sodomites, those who had killed their children, false religion, and any who supported it.

THIRD: THE SERVICE RENDERED.

II CHRONICLES 34:31-33

When Josiah made the decision to keep God's Commandments, "with all his heart," then the people followed his leadership. I am always amazed that people in America expect their leader not to live by his faith. So insane! Everyone lives by their faith, either in or out of office. Every decision is based upon what you believe. "Leave your religion in the church building!" No! A thousand times no! President Barack Obama makes his beliefs known every single day. He makes it plain that he is for abortion, government control, booze, illegal immigration, and same-sex marriage, and declares, "Love wins!"

Same-Sex Marriage Will Abolish Civil Rights

Bentonville Public School District in Arkansas is waiting on the Supreme Court's decision on marriage before deciding whether or not students can use locker rooms and restrooms of their "gender identity" rather than their biological sex.

When the Supreme Court announces its decision on marriage,... it will affect much more than whether or not a state can define marriage as between one man and one woman. It will affect how children as young as kindergarten are taught, how Christian businesses are run, and even whom churches and Christian schools can hire.

Bentonville Public School District board member and Wal-Mart attorney Grant Lightle has proposed adding "sexual orientation and gender identity" to the school's nondiscrimination policy. "The Wal-Mart attorney needs to learn that discriminating between good and bad is what consumers do every day, and most agree that allowing boys to share a shower with their daughters is not good," said Mat Staver, founder and chairman of Liberty Counsel.

In a letter to the school district board, Liberty Counsel suggested that Mr. Lightle assist the megastore in getting its own house in order before changing the school's policies. After the megastore added "gender identity" to its nondiscrimination policy, offenses increased. For example, Wal-Mart employee Martin "Marty" Ortiz in Billings, Montana insisted on using the women's restroom over the objections of nearly 40 female employees....

Furthermore, the letter pointed out that when school districts add homosexuality and cross-dressing to legitimate protected classes, those districts also add those categories to the curriculum. Earlier [in May], Fairfax County, Virginia Public Schools added homosexuality and gender identity to its protected classes and two days later proposed adding homosexuality and transgender to the curriculum, stating that parents "do not have an opt-out option."

"The push for transgender rights is all a part of the homosexual agenda to create sexual anarchy in order to destroy marriage, morality, and objective truth," said Mat Staver. "This is not civil rights; this is the abolition of civil rights. It is the deconstruction of objective reality and natural law."

Two North Carolina Churches Vandalized by Homosexuals

Two North Carolina churches recently suffered thousands of dollars in damage as their buildings and property were trashed and spray-painted with pro-homosexual messages.

Officials of [a] Wesleyan church in Jamestown arrived...to find the church sign broken and pelted with eggs and silly string. Some of the church windows had been smashed, flowers were uprooted, and parking signs were ripped out [of] the ground. The hood of the church bus was scratched as if it had been keyed, and a sign was shoved through the front grill.

A number of messages were also spray-painted on the building, including "Gay's ok," "God loves!" and "He hates you!"

On Sunday, officials at [a] Baptist church in Greensboro also arrived to find similar damages to their building and property. A window had been broken, eggs had been pelted at the building, and toilet paper was strewn around the outside of the facility.

Pro-homosexual messages were also sprawled across the brick building.
