inerrant, perfect Word for our learning so that we could HOLD THE SCRIPTURES IN OUR HANDS AND LEARN FROM THEM. We might have patience, comfort, and hope. What patience, comfort and hope is there to be gained "through the scriptures" if we do not HAVE the Scriptures???

If we do not have a perfect translation, we do not HAVE the Scriptures . . . and don't let some double -talking ALEXANDRIAN tell you any different! Just because the ALEXANDRIAN'S puny little sissybritches effeminate god cannot get his word into more than the "original" languages . . . don't think the Almighty God of the Bible cannot do it! He gave the Great Commission, knowing full well that the "original autographs" would pass out of existence . . . and knowing full well that in order for His New Testament church to carry the Commission to its fulfillment, His Word would have to be translated into other languages. If such a thing were impossible, HE WOULD NEVER HAVE GIVEN THE COMMISSION!

Recently, I received a packet in the mail from an ALEXANDRIAN named Milton Carr. I have never heard of him, but I get lots of mail from people whom I have never met and who attempt to straighten me out on my "King James only" error. Mr. Carr is apparently connected somehow with a Baptist church in Castle Dale, Utah. He may be the pastor. I don't know. He never says.

Anyway, he enclosed two articles in the packet. One was the photostatic copy of a book some unidentified ALEXANDRIAN wrote to destroy faith in the King James Bible. The writer says in essence, that the King James Bible cannot be trusted because it has gone through a great number of "revisions." That is a LIE! My dictionary says to revise is to "look over and correct." Other than printers' errors (which were taken care of quickly), there has been no revising. There was nothing to CORRECT. There were CHANGES, yes. The English language underwent a vast change in the first 158 years after the 1611 edition was published. Most of it was in spelling. Up until the early eighteenth century, there were no set rules as to the spelling of English words. This is why in the original 1611 version there are often several spellings for the same word. When this began to be changed, new EDITIONS of the King James Bible were printed.

There is a difference between a revision and an edition. The dictionary says to edit is to "prepare for publication." It says an edition is "the form in which something is published." The FORM of the King James Bible was changed six times after the original 1611 edition due to changes in spelling and punctuation in the English language ... but there were NO revisions!

Lest We Forget


Ricardo Hechanova was taken as a prisoner of war while he was fighting and taken to the camp where the survivors of the Bataan death march stayed. He became the officer in charge of burial duty and planned the burials and kept the records of all who were buried. He says he buried about 6,000 Americans and 20,000 Filipinos. He said the most he ever burled in one day was 496 soldiers. He felt so sorry for the young American soldiers he burled who died so far away from home, defending the freedom of another country. He

claimed it was very hard on the soldiers who helped with the burials. They could hardly keep up with the work of digging the graves so they would dig very long trenches and then bury the soldiers, covering them up with a very thin layer of dirt. The next day they would continue to put bodies on top of them. At first the dogs would come out at night and try to dig up bodies. The Japanese allowed them to post guards to keep the dogs away.

Mr. Hechanova would stay up at night In his little hut with a candle. He would try to accurately write down the details of the men he burled. One night he said it was raining and he heard someone banging on the door. He thought it must have been the Japanese but when he held the candle up he saw it was a solider covered in mud. The soldier acted like he was crazy. He had been buried alive. When it rained he woke up. There were no doctors who would pronounce the soldiers dead and they just assumed a soldier was dead and buried them. It's sad to hear these stories and what these men had to go through. They deserve to be honored.

Keeping Private Matters Private

When Hillary reached the age where she could work in the church nursery I noticed something She started learning a lot more than how to care for babies and toddlers; she was learning the latest details of people's private lives! This was more than we had bargained for!

Ladies, we need to be far more discreet in the conversations that we have with others. Even if no one else could hear it but you, the other person and the Lord, it would matter what is being said Private matters should not be discussed in places where others could overhear the conversation. In some cases, there are topics that are so personal in nature that they were not meant to be discussed with outsiders at all.

One of the most common mistakes that women make in this area is discussing things that are going on in their marriages. You may be one of the unhappiest women on the planet, but you won't make it better by complaining about it to another woman. Discretion would require that you save such a discussion for an appropriate time and place and have it with the right person, which would be someone in a position to provide you with godly counsel. Talking about problems is natural, but we can cross a line when we reveal too many details to people who are neither part of the problem nor part of the solution.

Another area where we can get into trouble is discussing what we think of other people's children. This is especially tempting if we work with children, as we are naturally prone to evaluate their strengths and weaknesses if we are involved in their lives. If we have observations or suggestions to make, this type of discussion should be done in the presence of the parents of the child. We must guard against the temptation to pick apart someone else's parenting skills! This is counter-productive. A far more effective course would be to speak with the parent directly, and only if the issue is of great importance, such as a child that bites other children or throws toys or has other behavioral problems.

"Lucifer" Fox TV Series "Mocks the Bible" Says One Million Moms' Petition

The American Family Association's One Million Moms website has launched a petition calling for Fox to halt its plans to air a new television series called Lucifer in 2016, saying the program "mischaracterizes" Satan and 'mocks the Bible."

"The series will focus on Lucifer portrayed as a good guy, 'who is bored and unhappy as the lord of Hell," the petition states.

The premise of the series, which is based on the DC Comics series of the same name, is that the protagonist, Lucifer Morningstar, decides to leave Hell and move to Los Angeles, the City of Angels, to open up an upscale nightclub called Lux....

"The program previews mischaracterize Satan, depart from true biblical teachings about him, and inaccurately portray the beliefs of the Christian faith," the petition argues. "By choosing to air this show, Fox is disrespecting Christianity and mocking the Bible."...

"Previews of the pilot episode depict graphic acts of violence, a nightclub featuring scantilyclad women, and a demon," the petition continues.


