The doctrine of the Resurrection is a cardinal doctrine of Christianity. The Resurrection is the Constitution, the Bill of Rights, and the Declaration of Independence of Christianity.

I Corinthians 15:14, "And if Christ be not risen, then our preaching is vain, and your faith is also vain." Vain here means 'empty' or 'worthless.'

FIRST: THE PREACHING OF THE RESURRECTION.

When Paul preached on the Resurrection in Athens, some people even laughed at the doctrine. Paul preached boldly that the sign of Christianity was not the Cross, but the empty tomb. Why? Because it would be foolish to place your faith in what Christ did on the cross if He left no way out of eternal death.

Christians have the only living originator of Faith. Buddha is dead. Brahma is dead. Muhammad is Dead. Karl Marx is dead. They are all dead with nothing to offer. We serve a living Saviour which is Christ.

SECOND; THE POWER OF THE RESURRECTION.

LUKE 24:41

"... believed not for joy... "

When the disciples saw the resurrected Christ, they were so happy that they believed not for joy. Have you never had something so wonderful that, at first, you could not believe it, yet it was true?

Think of the power of the Resurrection. After the crucifixion of Christ, they all fled and hid. Then up from the grave He arose. Those same fearful disciples were now standing up boldly for the resurrected Christ who they had recently seen with their own eyes. The Resurrection had removed the mystery of death and what was beyond it. It takes away the fear of the unknown because it allows us to get a glimpse of Who and what is on the other side.

THIRD: THE PROOFS OF THE RESURRECTION.

I CORINTHIANS 15:1-8

In I Corinthians 1-4, we are taught specifically what the gospel actually is. It is: "Christ died for our sins ... He was buried ... He rose again the third day according to the scriptures ..."

"Seen of Cephas ... then of the twelve ... seen of 500 ... seen of James ... seen of the Apostles seen of me ..." Paul was referring to his personal meeting with the resurrected Christ.

From our Pastor's Wife ... Mrs. Vida Collingsworth Lying




We live in a society of habitual liars. I know that sounds harsh, but it is true. It is not just the telling of whoppers, or outright lying—but it is the withholding of the truth.

Sanctuary Cities

<u>Transgender Mania: Ohio Court Gives Custody</u> <u>of Transgender Teen To Grandparents</u>

In February, an Ohio trial court judge gave custody of a 17-year old transgender male (born female) to the teen's grandparents after the teen's parents sought to bar the hormonal transition treatment strongly recommended by the youth's medical team. Grandparents will now be able to make medical decisions for the teen. The parents had argued that the teen was not old enough to make such a consequential decision.

A county prosecutor contended that the parents objected because of their religious beliefs. Court testimony revealed that the parents, in addition to opposing treatment, refused to call the youth by her chosen name, triggering suicidal feelings in her

Supreme Court: Bestiality the "Law of the Land"

According to the Supreme Court of Canada, most bestiality is now the "law of the land" in our northern neighbor.

The 7-1 ruling stemmed from a case involving a British Columbia man convicted of 13 counts of assaulting his stepdaughters - including one count of bestiality. The abuser, identified only as "DLW", was acquitted of the bestiality count with the new ruling. Justice Rosalie Abella was the lone dissenter.

The trial judge held that bestiality in the Criminal Code meant touching between a person and an animal for a lascivious purpose. DLW's attorneys argued that bestiality was linked to "buggery" - or sodomy - with animals, but the definition did not encompass every carnal act with animals. Seven of the justices agreed.

An opponent of the ruling was quoted as saying, "Canadian law gives animal abusers license to use animals for gratification. This is completely unacceptable, contrary to societal expectations, and cannot be allowed to continue."
