I cannot tell how many times I have seen a backslidden wife take her family with her. I cannot tell how many times I have seen a backslidden young adult or teenager take his family with him. When a person runs, he sells out not just himself but those whom he says he loves.

Lest We Forget



Theodore Roosevelt, Jr.

Theodore Roosevelt Jr., the Plattsburgh-trained son of a U.S. president, was commissioned as a major in 1917. On June 20 of that year, he and brother Archie sailed to France after a letter of endorsement from their father, allowing them to fight in the first wave under Gen. John Pershing's American Expeditionary Forces.

Roosevelt Jr. fought through enemy fire and poison gas, leading from the front. He received high praise, was promoted and commanded the 26th Regiment of the 1st Division. Gassed nearly to blindness, he refused

evacuation and received the Silver Star for his actions at Cantigny. Later, near Soissons, Roosevelt Jr. was shot in the left leg. While recuperating at a field hospital, he reportedly met a Sgt. William Patterson, later killed in action, who inspired Lt. Col. Roosevelt Jr. to help launch The American Legion.

At 56, Brig. Gen. Roosevelt Jr. came ashore at Utah Beach in the first wave of the World War II D-Day invasion of June 6, 1944. Armed with nothing more than a pistol and his cane, he helped soldiers cross the beach to safety, eluding enemy fire. For his actions that day, Roosevelt Jr. received the Medal of Honor.

John Wayne's Spicy Grilled Chicken Breasts

PROVISIONS 4 bone-in, skin-on chicken breasts Olive oil, for chicken Vegetable oil, for grill

SAUCE 2 tbsp. butter 2 tbsp. honey 1 tbsp. hot sauce SPICE RUB

1 tbsp. smoked paprika 2 tsp. kosher or fine sea salt 1 tsp. garlic powder 1/2 tsp. chipotle chili powder 1 tsp. onion powder

2 tbsp. brown sugar



Things are just hotter in the West, including this delicious chicken recipe.

SPICERUB

Combine all ingredients in a small bowl.

CHICKEN

Brush the chicken breasts with olive oil and rub liberally with the spice rub. Let sit for 15 minutes at room temperature. Prepare grill for direct and indirect heat and preheat to medium-high. Brush the grill grates with vegetable oil. Place the chicken breasts skin side up on the indirect heat side of the grill. Grill with the lid closed for 15 minutes. Flip the chicken and grill for 20 minutes or until an internal temperature of 160 degrees F is reached. SAUCE

While chicken is grilling, heat the butter, honey and hot sauce together in a small saucepan. When the chicken breasts have reached an internal temperature of 160 degrees F, brush with the sauce, move to the direct heat side of the grill and grill for 1 minute. Brush with more sauce, flip and grill for another minute. Remove chicken breasts from grill, brush with more sauce and serve.

Planned Parenthood Not Reporting Sexual Assault to Authorities

The Planned Parenthood abortion chain has been caught repeatedly performing abortions on abuse victims as young as 12 and 13 years old, failing to report suspected sexual abuse to authorities, and sending victims back to their abusers. UMC Megachurch Hosts Ramadan Dinner With Muslims

The largest United Methodist Church congregation in the United States hosted a dinner with the local Muslim community as part of the Islamic season of Ramadan.

Church of the Resurrection of Leawood. Kansas,...hosted the iftar dinner, the meal which Muslims eat after sunset during Ramadan, on May 22.

In an interview with the Christian Post on Wednesday, [Pastor] Hamilton explained that his church wanted to "dissipate fear" and "demonstrate the love of Christ" by holding the event.

"We've been trying to look for ways to build bridges with the Muslim community in Kansas City and to demonstrate the love of Christ to them," said Hamilton

About 320 people attended the event ... including about 40 Muslims. In addition to dinner the event featured opening remarks by Hamilton and a Muslim representative of the interfaith group the Dialogue Institute of Kansas City...

Some have expressed concern over churches, especially mainline Protestant denominations, holding events for the Islamic community out of concern that they are either compromising the Gospel or are oblivious to extremism.
