PALM SUNDAY



Introduction: The event that I am teaching on in this article occurred on Palm Sunday, the day in which Jesus descended down the Mount of Olives going toward Jerusalem, riding upon a colt.

In **Luke 19:28-41**, Jesus gives an unusual command to two of the disciples. **“Go ye into the village over against you; in the which at your entering ye shall find a colt tied, whereon yet never a man sat; loose him, and bring him hither.”**

FIRST: PROPHECY FULFILLED.

ZECHARIAH 9:9

“...behold, thy king cometh...upon a colt....”

It was preached throughout the centuries that the true king of Israel would one day enter Jerusalem riding upon a colt never ridden by another.

The donkey in Israel was not the “beast of burden” that is in many countries, but was considered a noble animal.

When a king in Israel would go into battle he would ride a horse, but when coming in peace he would ride a donkey. Jesus was delivering a message of peace and not war.

This colt was special, just like the mother of Jesus, and the tomb where His body was placed. Mary was a virgin that never knew a man. The tomb was never used for the dead, and the colt had never been ridden by another.

SECOND: PORTRAIT REVEALED.

EXODUS 13:13

“Every firstling of an ass thou shalt redeem with a lamb...”

When we look at this colt, or donkey, it's the same thing, we see a beautiful portrait of the people who have placed their trust in Jesus Christ as Saviour.

I. **Redeemed by the blood of the Lamb. Exodus 13:13**

II. **Released for service. John 8:32, “And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.”**

III. **Ruled by its master. Romans 6:13**

This little donkey did not hesitate to yield and serve Christ.

THIRD: PREPARED FOR A PURPOSE.

LUKE 19:31

“And if any man ask you, why do ye loose him? Thus shall ye say unto him, because the Lord hath need of him.”

Just as Jesus has prepared you for His service, the Lord had prepared this donkey for a specific purpose.

- The whale in Jonah was prepared for a specific purpose
 - The fish with a coin in its mouth was prepared for a specific purpose
 - The snake that bit the Apostle Paul on Malta was prepared for a specific purpose
- You were prepared for a specific purpose. Make up your mind to serve the Lord. You are here for a reason.

Starting this year, the Army will begin issuing the new service dress uniforms – to recruiters first, with a full rollout in 2020. The new "Army greens" are historically accurate representations of the "pink and greens" – so called due to the pinkish hue the pants could assume after laundering - worn by iconic World War II officers like Army Chief of Staff Gen. George C. Marshall.

Dailey wore a prototype of the throwback uniform at the Army-Navy football game in December. "I'm one of the guys who gets to walk onto the field with the president, so the cameras were there," Dailey said. "I didn't have to tell anybody what it was. I didn't have to remind anybody. I was immediately recognized as, 'You look like a soldier.' That was the intent."

Then as Jesus journeyed toward Jerusalem, the people spread their clothes, their other cloaks upon the road for the donkey that carried the King. This pictured that what God has redeemed should walk separated from the filth of this world. The donkey was redeemed and belonged to the Lord Christ. What belongs to Christ is to walk a godly, separated life.

The question for you is this, Do you think so much of your possessions that you would not use what you have to help those redeemed separate from the world?

Conclusion: Right now could be the turning point of your life. If you are not saved, put your faith and trust in the Christ Who shed His blood for your sins right now. If you are not serving Him, then that means you have less sense than a donkey. Why not dedicate yourself to know and follow Christ right now?

The Question of Women Preachers

The question of women preachers is settled by the Bible. First, it is the uniform practice of both the Old and the New Testament that God did not call women preachers. There were no women apostles, no women pastors, no women evangelists in the Bible. And second, the Scripture expressly teaches: ***"Let your women keep silence in the churches: for it is not permitted unto them to speak"*** (I Cor. 14:34). And again, ***"Let the woman learn in silence with all subjection. But I suffer not a woman to teach, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence"*** (I Tim. 2:11, 12).

We "moderns" feel that we know so many ways to do the Lord's business that are better than His ways. But when Nadab and Abihu went into the tabernacle, carrying strange fire, not the appointed fire, they were stricken dead by an angry God (Lev. 10:1, 2). When David brought the ark up to Jerusalem on an oxcart instead of the Lord's way, he had trouble, and death struck the man who touched the ark (II Sam. 6:6, 7). And even when the good king Uzziah went into the temple to offer sacrifice, where it was forbidden for anybody but the priest, God struck him with leprosy (II Chron. 26:16-21). And when Miriam the prophetess wanted to usurp authority in religious work, wanted to take a place of leadership like some men had, God struck her with leprosy for her sin (Num. 12:10). And so today there is a curse, a plague of an angry God on churches because we do things our own way instead of the way of God.

May God help us to bring the Lord back into His churches and put Him first. May we take women out of the pulpits. May we take worldliness out of the pew. May God give us grace to take cowardice out of the preachers. And may God give us a heart to put Him first.

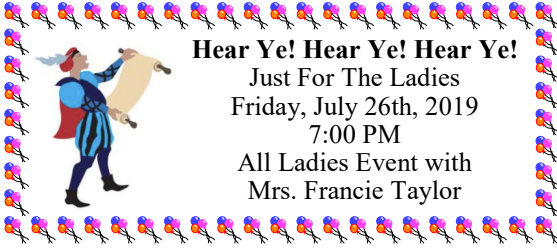

Dreams Upon A Lie

God reminds us in **Jeremiah 23:23-24**, that He is God. He is omnipresent. He sees all. He knows all. Then God speaks again in verse 25. In the last part of that verse, He tells of prophets who are prophesying lies in His name. We need to be reminded that there are people who say that they are speaking in the name of God, but God says that those same people are lying. In verse 32, He says that He did not send them. There are some that say God sent them, but He did not send them. He says of them in verse 25, **"prophesy lies in my name that those same people saying, I have dreamed, I have dreamed."** Who are we listening to?

In this passage of Scripture, God points out that there are some who say that they are speaking in the name of God, who are prophesying in the name of God. We can know who they are because they say, "I have dreamed, I have dreamed." Today, neither the world nor our nation is in good spiritual condition. The spiritual condition of a group of people is always determined by the leadership that they follow and to which they listen. It has always been that way. In this period of time in the book of Jeremiah, God's people, the people of Israel, were listening to these whom God says He did not send. They are spiritually destitute. They are not anywhere close to where God would have them to be. God is going to pour out His wrath upon them. He is going to send His judgment. It all can be traced back to when they turned from God. We are told they were listening to those whom God called "dreamers."

California Attorney General Wants to Hide Videos

The California Attorney General Xavier Becerra is asking the Superior Court of San Francisco to seal and hide from the public all of the undercover videos that reveal Planned Parenthood's unethical and potentially illegal conduct involving the sale of baby body parts, even though these are the same videos now being used by the state to criminally prosecute Sandra "Susan" Merritt and David Daleiden.

Attorney General Becerra has also asked "that any monitor displaying the videos be screened from or directed away from the public gallery," to prohibit any public viewing. In addition, he seeks the continued sealing of all the complaining witnesses' names.

At the two-week evidentiary preliminary hearing, scheduled for February 19 to March 1, 2019, the attorney general is required to demonstrate that he has probable cause to...charge Merritt and Daleiden with 15 felonies for their undercover journalistic investigation, which exposed Planned Parenthood's unconscionable practices. Statutory and constitutional law clearly entitles Merritt and Daleiden to be tried in a public proceeding, including a preliminary hearing that is open to the public.

Make It Right

We are destined to be offended sooner or later. Your feelings will get hurt eventually. There will be divisions and strife. It is going to happen, and we cannot stop it, but we can correct it! You cannot keep little differences from occurring, but God Almighty has given us a plan to keep us from holding grudges against each other. It is a very simple Bible principle; that is, for the stronger person to go to the weaker person.

By the way, there is no such thing in the Bible as a universal church. You only have local churches in the Scriptures. I shudder when I hear preachers refer to the body of Christ, as if there were some mystical body or universal body. There is no such thing in the Scriptures. We must realize this is a Catholic teaching, not a Bible teaching.

I mention this because there is a difference between the words unity and union. No two local churches are alike, and God planned it that way. Be careful when someone cries for a synthetic union. There is supposed to be unity in the local church without a union of local churches. The only pastor a church member should have is the pastor of the church to which he belongs.

The attempt to get everyone in fundamentalism on the same page is a losing endeavor and a dangerous endeavor. If we are not careful, independents will become a denomination, just as the Bible Baptist Fellowship did after years of declaring their independence locally. That is exactly what the Southern Baptist Churches claim, as they suspend their autonomy once a year in Nashville. Thus, these principles are for the local church.

Now, back to the ranch! When conflict occurs within a local church, the relationship is important. It is more important than making things right. In order to salvage the relationship, the person who has been wronged must make things right with the person who wronged him.
