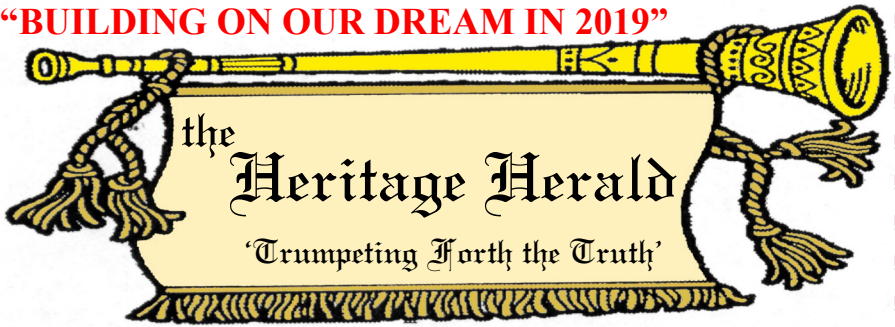

THE OLD-TIME RELIGION

Introduction: For the past several years we have had the honor of having an Old-Time Religion Conference here at Heritage Baptist Church. It is scheduled in the latter part of June between Father's Day and the Fourth of July. Why? Because the old-time religion has always been associated with old-fashioned homes with Godly fathers and a desire for freedom. Nothing has led to the destruction of our society more than broken homes without a father and the loss of freedom due to alcohol and drug use. The old-time religion gets us to take a good look at what a home and church should be. Allow me to share a few thoughts on the old time religion.

FIRST: A RELIGION OF FAITH.

ROMANS 10:13

"For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved."

The faith that I am speaking of is not some imaginary belief based upon feelings, but a solid faith based upon God's Word.

A man told me after I had witnessed to him, "Oh yes, I am a Christian. I have always been a Christian, but I do not believe the Bible, nor do I believe in an organized Church."

Saving faith is based upon God's Word. Without faith in the Word of God, your faith is foolish.

1. Jesus is the Word. *John 1:1, John 1:14*
2. The New Birth must come through the Word. *II Peter 1:23*

By the way, saving faith is believing God's Word to the degree that you will do what it says. May I remind you that you only believe that which moves you to an action.

SECOND: A RELIGION FOR THE WHOLE FAMILY.

JOSHUA 24:15

"As for me and my house we will serve the Lord."

While out visiting I ran across a man that went to a Mormon church and his wife went to a Baptist Church. Think of how foolish this is.

Matthew 12:25, "... every city or house divided against itself shall not stand."

Acts 16:31, "... and thy house."

The old-time religion is for all of your family, not just you.

THIRD: A RELIGION THAT GOD FAVORS.

JEREMIAH 6:16

"Thus saith the Lord, stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way ..."

I am so sick and tired of megachurches with their pastors sitting on bar stools with their shirts open to reveal their hairy chest and swaying to rock and roll music filled with Jesus words and saying this is the old-time religion. How foolish!

God has always favored the old-time religion, never a modern version that is twisted beyond all recognition of holiness.

FOURTH: A RELIGION THAT REMOVES THE FILTH.

NEHEMIAH 4:10

"... there is much rubbish so that we are not able to build ..."

When the Hebrews went back from captivity to rebuild Jerusalem, the first thing they noticed was all the rubbish. What did they do? They cleared it away.

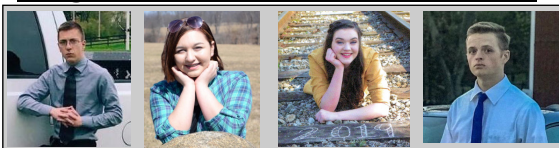

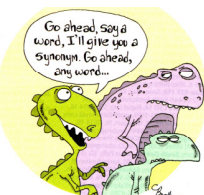

Remembering Normandy



Members of the 82nd Airborne Division listen as retired Army Col. Bob Piper, a World War II veteran, describes the battle that took place in St. Mère-Église. In 1984, the soldiers traveled to Normandy to participate in activities marking the 40th anniversary of D-Day.

FIFTH: A RELIGION THAT FIGHTS.

JUDE 3

"... *ye should earnestly contend for the faith* ..."

Notice that it says, "contend for the faith." So! What does the faith consist of?

1. The doctrine of Creationism—fight for it! *Genesis 1:1*
2. The doctrine of the inspired Word of God—fight for it! *II Peter 3:16*
3. The doctrine of the Virgin Birth—fight for it! *Matthew 1:27*
4. The doctrine of a sinless Christ—fight for it! *II Corinthians 5:21*
5. The doctrine of Grace—fight for it! *Ephesians 2:8-9*
6. The doctrine of the Blood—fight for it! *Ephesians 1:7, Revelation 1:5*
7. The doctrine of the local New Testament Church—fight for it! *Colossians 1:18*

What I am trying to convey to you is that, if it is in the Bible, fight for it!

Conclusion: The old-time religion is endless because it is eternal. I could spend a lifetime and not cover the hem of the garment of the old-time religion. It is so deep that it is endless in description, yet so simple that a child can grasp it.

Allow me to close with this wonderful truth: The old-time religion has one main goal: to get you saved. Before you start trying to figure everything out, you need to confirm that you are actually saved. Right now, would you be willing to pray with me?

Prayer of Salvation

If you were to die today, are you 100% sure you would go to Heaven?

If not, would you be willing to pray this prayer with me?

'Dear Jesus, I'm asking you to come into my heart and forgive me of my sins. I'm trusting you, Jesus, as my Saviour. Thank you for saving me. Amen.' (Romans 10:9 and 10:13)

Confess

***"He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy."* Proverbs 28:13**

Are we real, or are we pretending to be Christians? If we're real, we have nothing to hide; but if we're just putting on a pre-packed show based on fine training, one day we're going to forget to act the part.

When people have a tremendous moral failure in their lives, it wasn't born the same day it happened. A process was going on behind the scenes leading up to the big "fall"; and in many cases, the process took place over several months, if not years.

It's easy to present an image to people, leading them to believe that we're virtually flawless. Admiration is one of the easiest prizes to earn; but while we may be able to fool others, God

has never been tricked by any charade. In fact, our lives are like movies on a large screen, visible to God at any time. ***"The eyes of the LORD are in every place, beholding the evil and the good"* (Proverbs 15:3).**

Too bad God can't give us a sneak preview of that movie screen. He sees the beginning, middle and end result of our choices and decisions. We don't have that kind of vision. In fact, sometimes we're not even thinking about consequences or end results. We're just thinking of ourselves.

The best policy for transgression is confession. When we're swift and honest, the consequences may be swifter in coming, but so is the resolution. But if we're secretive and deceitful, we're taking the long route to embarrassment and humiliation.

Do you have something to hide? If you want to escape the torture chamber of guilt, abandon the cover-up efforts and confess to those who need to know. It may be a painful experience, but getting caught in a lie is far more painful, and tremendously destructive.

People have a greater tendency to be merciful and understanding to those who can readily admit their wrongs than to those who simply run out of options in the midst of dishonest double-lives.

A Young Man Should Seek Counsel From His Elders, Not His Peers.

1 Kings 12:8, "But he (Rehoboam) forsook the counsel of the old men, which they had given him, and consulted with the young men that were grown up with him, and which stood before him: ..."

Rehoboam was the son of King Solomon. Upon the death of his father, Rehoboam inherited his father's throne, but sadly, not his father's wisdom. He had access to much of that wisdom through both his father's writings and his father's peers. The "old men" who had served with Solomon tried to give him sound and sage advice. This young king forsook their counsel and turned his ears to his peers. These young men possessed no greater wisdom than Rehoboam—they were his contemporaries and thus they simply mirrored his knowledge and experience. Yet he chose to follow their untested advice. As a result, a nation was plunged into civil war.

11 Kings 6:17, "And Elisha prayed, and said, LORD, I pray thee, open his eyes, that he may see. And the LORD opened the eyes of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha."

This young man, who was a servant to Elisha, learned that the older, godly man could see things that he was not yet able to see. One of the reasons that a young man should seek counsel from older, more experienced men is that they have a perspective he has not been afforded. Their spiritual, experienced eyes can see what youthfulness cannot.

One of the downfalls of young men in our society is that they have developed a foolish dedication and arrogant loyalty to their peers.

Warnings Issued About Deadly, Disturbing Transgender Danger

A former transgender activist and a mother whose daughter identifies as transgender spoke out against the danger of pushing or encouraging transgenderism in children.

The two spoke at [an April 2] panel discussion at the Heritage Foundation in Washington, D.C. The panel...addressed the issues that come along with assisting children with a transition.

Walt Heyer, the trans activist who recently announced that the media and doctors misled him to believe that the answer to gender dysphoria was a transition, warned of the dangers to children of encouraging early transitions.

“We are manufacturing transgender kids,” Heyer later added. “We are manufacturing their depression, their anxiety, and have turned it into a huge industry that people are profiting from after kids lives are completely torn apart.”

“Elaine”, who requested to be anonymous, said that she is speaking out against transgenderism to help children parents and family members.

“Parents are doing everything they can to help their kids lead happy, healthy, and fulfilling lives, yet when parents seek out experts for help, they receive a one-size-fits-all narrative that has no basis in science, common sense, or compassion.”

It's Just Rebellion

One day every knee shall bow to Christ and every tongue shall confess that He is Lord, to the glory of God the Father, we are told (*Phil. 2:10, 11*). That must be sometime. Why not let it be before your soul is damned and lost forever?

John 3:18 tells us that, “**He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.**” And then we have an explanation of why every soul that ever goes to Hell does so. It is given in the following verses, *John 3:19-21*, which say,

“**And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reprov'd. But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.**”

Jesus promised that, “**... him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out**” (*John 6:37*). It is not the head that keeps you away from God. It is that stubborn, rebellious will of yours.

*“I'll go where you want me to go, dear Lord,
Over mountain or plain or sea;
I'll say what you want me to say, dear Lord,
I'll be what you want me to be.”*
