
Jesus Christ came not only as the Saviour but as the King of kings.

1 lb bulk pork sausage 1 package (7 oz.) herb-2 eggs, well beaten 1/2 cup chopped celery seasoned stuffing croutons 1 to 1-1/2 cups chicken broth 2 tbsp. minced fresh parsley 3/4 cup fresh cranberries, 1/4 cup chopped onions halved

In a skillet, cook sausage, celery and onion until sausage is done and vegetables are tender. Drain excess fat. In a large mixing bowl, combine the meat mixture with remaining ingredients and enough broth to hold mixture together. Shape into 8-10 balls. Place in a greased shallow baking dish. Bake at 325 for 30 minutes. 8-10 servings.



Some of the most popular myths about angels are seen quite often in comic strips or joke books. You will see cartoons which depict some person who was "good" on earth, who died and is now seen in Heaven as an angel. He is sitting on a white cloud with a halo over his head and wings sticking out of his back. While he strums a harp with a stupid look on his simple face, he makes wisecracks to a female angel.

There are several things wrong with these myths:

First: Nobody goes to Heaven because they are good.

People go to Heaven because they admit they are NOT good, repent of their sins, chuck their religion down the drain (where it belongs!) and receive Jesus Christ as their own personal Saviour. (See Luke 13:3, I Thess. 1:9, John 1:12).

Second: Human beings who die and go to Heaven DO NOT BECOME ANGELS.

You would be surprised how many people I find in Bible-believing BAPTIST churches who think they are going to become angels in Heaven. Their total ignorance on this subject is apalling!

Third: Angels do not sit around Heaven on clouds.

There is nothing in Scripture to even hint at such a thing. We are never told that Heaven even has any clouds.

Fourth: There are no female angels.

Angels were often mistaken for MEN, but never for WOMEN. The angels have masculine names. When described with a singular pronoun, it is always "he." The Bible narrative, itself, calls them "MEN" many times. (See Gen. 18:2; 19:1; Mark 16:5, for example).

Though a great deal of mystery surrounds these fascinating heavenly beings, God has revealed much about them in His Word. To a great degree, He has lifted the curtain that enfolds the mystery of the angels.

Since you and I who are saved will be spending eternity with the angels, I believe it is vastly important that we learn all we can of these heavenly beings now, in preparation for eternity. Not only that, but we are surrounded by them at this very moment. They are vitally interested in US. If they are interested in US, we certainly should be interested in THEM!

They can learn of us by watching and listening. We can learn of them ONLY by studying the Word of God. To coin a phrase from Paul — I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren — concerning these celestial beings called ANGELS.

Air Force Punishes Colonel Who Refused to Affirm Gay Marriage

The Air Force has punished a highly decorated and respected colonel after he refused to affirm publicly the same-sex spouse of a retiring subordinate.
