The Military's Oldest Medal



The Purple Heart was originally called the Badge of Military Merit when George Washington created it in 1782. Only three documented awards were

given before it fell into disuse. In 1932, Army Chief of Staff General Douglas MacArthur revived it. The medal was redesigned as a purple heart with a bronze border encircling a portrait of George Washington. MacArthur awarded it to soldiers who were wounded in action and to the families of those who died in combat. To date, nearly two million members of the U.S. armed forces have received medals.

Married To A Nabal

It's one thing to obey a man who is godly, a great leader, loving, kind, thoughtful and a generous provider for his wife and family. It's another matter entirely when the man is carnal, insensitive, cold, inattentive, too busy, stingy and mean on top of it all. There was a woman in the Bible who had a husband who had an ugly disposition. The wife's name was Abigail, and her husband's name was Nabal. The Bible itself tells us that the meaning of this man's name was "dolt" or "fool" (I Sam. 25:25). If you are not familiar with this story, go to I Samuel 25:2-42 for a fascinating true story of a disagreeable man married to a wise and beautiful woman. I am convinced that God allowed that story to be told in Scripture so that women who married Nabals in this life would find hope and

would carry on in the face of lengthy adversity.

Let's look at some characteristics of Nabal:

- 1. He was "churlish" (vs. 3). The word "churlish" only appears once in the Bible, and it was used as a description of Nabal's personality. Strong's Concordance defines this word in the following way: "severe, cruel, grievous, hard hearted, impudent, obstinate, rough, stiff and stubborn"!
- 2. He was "evil in his doings" (vs. 3). Nabal was a wicked man, and it doesn't seem from Scripture that he was at all ashamed of it. It is difficult tor a fool to see his own folly.
- 3. He was reckless and spoke harshly (vss. 10, 11). When David sent his men to ask for some small token in exchange for protecting Nabal's sheep and shepherds, Nabal responded hastily by insulting David and even insinuating that David and his men were runaway slaves!
- 4. He was a drunkard (vs. 36). Nabal had a feast during which he drank himself into a drunken stupor. He was merry while he was intoxicated, but "when the wine was gone out of Nabal" (vs. 37), it was time to face reality.
- 5. Ultimately, Nabal's wicked lifestyle cost him his life (vss. 37, 38). Nabal had lived an evil life for so long that it finally caught up with him. His own harshness ended up dealing him a fatal blow. Does any of this sound familiar? Does it describe the man that you married?

Illustration: A plaque on the wall behind the desk of my old 1st Sergeant from my army days read, "An excuse measures zero meters." I believe he was saying the sentiment of God.

<u>Conclusion:</u> I have always said that the best explanation of faithfulness is: Being where you are supposed to be, doing what you are supposed to do, every time you are supposed to do it. Sounds like the perfect will of God to me. Let's be faithful!

London Spice Steak

Lean flank steak gets an Indonesian flavor from grilling with a coating of brown sugar and a few spices.

1 1/2 tbsp firmly packed light 2 tsp olive oil brown sugar 4 cloves garlic, minced

1 1/2 tsp chili powder 1/2 tsp ground ginger

1/2 tsp black pepper 1 (3-pound) flank steak

2 1/2 tsp ground coriander 1/2 tsp salt

1. Preheat grill to medium heat. Place the grill rack 8 inches from the heat.

- Combine the brown sugar, coriander, garlic, olive oil, chili powder, ginger, salt and black pepper in a small bowl. Mix well.
- Rub the brown sugar mixture on both sides of the steak. Place the steak on the grill and grill for 16 minutes, or until an instant-read thermometer inserted into the center reads 160°F, turning once.
- Cut the steak diagonally across the grain into 1/4-inch slices and serve.

Pakistan Local Government Destroyed Thirteen Christian Families' Homes

Thirteen Christian families in a small village located in the Punjab province of Pakistan are now homeless after the local municipal government demolished their homes because the families refused to work for no pay and become bonded laborers.

Members of the Christian families, who all worked at a local brick kiln in the village of Samundri, refused to continue working unless they received fair compensation for their labor. Pakistan Christian Post reports that the village's municipal government carried out the destruction of their homes...after being pressured to do so by the "influential" Muslims who owned the brick kiln operation....

With about 72 Christian families living in the majority Muslim village, all the Christian families in the town are forced to live in a segregated corner of the town because "they may not be mixed with the people of the majority religion."

Professor Anjum James Paul, chairman of the Pakistan Minorities Teachers Association, chastised the municipality for destroying the Christian homes. He said these families are now living without shelter and now have to cope with the cold winter nights.

"Shame on such elements who destroy the peace of mind and properties of the marginalized Christian community," Paul told the Pakistan Christian Post...

...In November, all the Christians in the Punjabi village of Sahiwal were forced to flee their homes after receiving threats the town's Muslims after one of the town's Christian men married a Muslim woman. With about 97 percent of Pakistan's population being Muslim the accusations made by Muslim people against religious minorities go a long way in the court of public opinion and the Pakistani court of law. Hundreds of religious minorities are killed, imprisoned or executed just because they have been accused, not proven guilty, of blasphemy.

In November, a Pakistani Christian couple was beaten, tortured and incinerated by a mob of over 1,500 people in the village of Kot Rodha Kishan all because they were accused of burning the pages from the Koran.

Kim Kline's Chicken and Broccoli Stir Fry



1 lb boneless skinless chicken breast, cut into 1-inch pieces 1 cup chicken broth 2 tsp finely chopped ginger 2 garlic cloves, finely chopped 3 tbsp soy sauce 2 tsp sugar 2 cups broccoli flowerets 2 tsp cornstarch

Spray nonstick skillet with cooking spray; heat over medium-high heat. Add chicken, garlic and ginger. Fry 2 to 3 minutes or until chicken is brown

Add 3/4 cup of the broth, the soy sauce and sugar. Cover and cook over medium heat 5 minutes, stirring twice.

Add broccoli. Cover and cook about 5 minutes, stirring occasionally, until chicken is no longer pink in center and broccoli are crisp-tender.

Mix cornstarch with remaining 1/4 cup broth; stir into chicken mixture. Cook, stirring frequently, until sauce is thickened. Serve over white rice.
