Fourth: A World Without The Simple Faith Of A Child. Matthew 18:3

- A child is teachable.
- · A child has faith.

Fifth: A World Without Soulwinners Who Care. Luke 2:11

"For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord."

Notice Luke 2:17, "... they made known abroad the saying which was told them concerning the child."
