A Mother's Influence

Introduction: Throughout the Bible as well as throughout history, we see the influence that mothers and grandmothers have had in directing the character and direction of their children and grandchildren.

Pastor & Mrs. C Old-Fashioned Sunday" The power of a mother's influence is incredible. Think about Ma Barker's influence in the lives of her children. When her first husband, George Barker, described as, "shiftless and lazy," by the FBI, died, Kate, (Ma Barker), lived in a relationship with a man

named Arthur Dunlap. Arthur Dunlap was known as a jobless man that no one could explain where he got his money. The rest is well known history as to what happened to the children. Ma Barker and her son, Fred Barker, were killed in a gun battle with the FBI in Lake Weir, Florida.

The Bible also has revealed the influence of a mother upon the life of a child. Notice: II Timothy 1:5, "When I call to remembrance the unfeigned faith that is in thee, which dwelt first in thy grandmother Lois, and thy mother Eunice; and I am persuaded that in thee also."

FIRST: A SUPREME OPPORTUNITY.

EXODUS 2:10

"...and she called his name Moses..."

Jochebed is a name very seldom spoken, but she was the mother of Moses. I do not have space to tell you the story of how she was allowed to raise her child in the palace of the Pharaoh of Egypt, but please read Exodus chapter two.

This mother, whose name is not well known in the annals of history, was used to mother a man who fathered a nation and blessed the entire world.

Mothers! Don't you believe it when this messed up world tries to convince you that working in a factory or advancing your career is a higher calling than being a dedicated mother to your child.

• An Opportunity to Love. Luke 13:34

I could not tell you how many women that my wife and I have known through the years that their lives were brightened by the birth of their child.

• An Opportunity to Train. *Proverbs* 22:6

No! I did not say, pack a lunch and send your child off to be trained by strangers that you don't even know. God expects you to do the majority of training.

The Pattern of Prayer



Introduction: Commonly called "The Lord's Prayer," this would be more aptly entitled, "The Disciples' Prayer." Each clause of this prayer teaches the Christian how and for what he should pray.

First: Prayer Should Include Fellowship - "Our Father."

This shows the affectionate and personal relationship that must exist in prayer. Prayer is a child talking with his Father.

Second: Prayer Should Include Adoration - "Hallowed be thy name."

We should learn that God is holy and powerful, while we are weak and sinful. We must reverence and honor Him. Even the name of God is to be honored. (In the ancient world the name was associated with one's character. To be disrespectful of a name was to dishonor the person.)

Third: Prayer Should Include Vision - "Thy kingdom come."

The vision includes a passion to win the lost and a desire to have God rule over all.

Fourth: Prayer Should Include Submission - "Thy will be done."

Just as God's will is directly and swiftly carried out in Heaven, so should His servants of earth be resolved to be obedient to His will. This means a surrender of our wants and desires to the commands of God.

Fifth: Prayer Should Include a Dependence on God - "Give us...our daily bread."

Too often we are prone to look at our possessions as our gain rather than gifts of God's grace for which we are responsible. In prayer, we should make known unto God that everything we have we recognize as coming

Sixth: Prayer Should Include Confession - "...forgive us our sins."

Thank God that we have the provision for forgiveness in prayer. I John 1:9 states, "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

Seventh: Prayer Should Include a Forgiving Spirit - "...for we also forgive."

This is a prayer to be like Christ (*Ephesians 4:32, Colossians 3:13*) and have a forgiving spirit toward others.

Eighth: Prayer Should Include a Plea for Strength and Guidance - "...lead us not into temptation."

Of course, God never tempts a man to do evil (James 1:12-14). But God does allow man to choose evil. However, a Christian must pray that God will give him strength and also help to avoid temptation. (I

Conclusion: May this help you to see prayer in such a way that you will want to practice it even more.

I KINGS 20:40

The tragedy in life is placing priorities on the trivial and trivializing that which should be a priority.

Illustration: I read the story of a house that caught on fire and burned to the ground. The tragedy was that the woman who was outside saw the house burning, ran into the house and began removing furniture. What she had forgotten was a child in the house that burned to death. The tragedy was that in all that business of saving things, she overlooked the most important thing—her child.

<u>Conclusion:</u> Mothers! You do a thousand decent, respectable things. But while you are busy, the peace that God wants to give you slips out of your life. While you are busy you lose interest in spending time in God's Word, and the altar in your home goes unused. While you are busy here and there, your sons and daughters stumble and fall over broken pieces of your Christless life.

ISNA (MUSLIM) ENDORSED CHAPLAINS IN U.S. MILITARY

The Islamic Society of North America (ISNA), a United States Muslim Brotherhood group, has proudly announced that the United States military will now be using their chaplains for active duty.

In 1991, the Muslim Brotherhood listed ISNA as one of its main groups. Declassified FBI memos said ISNA is a group of the Muslim Brotherhood, who sees its "work in America as a kind of grand jihad in eliminating and destroying the Western civilization from within."

In 2007, the United States government labeled ISNA a United States Muslim Brotherhood entity and an unindicted co-conspirator in a terrorism-financing trial involving the Holy Land Foundation tunneling money to Hamas. In 2009, because of "ample" evidence linking ISNA to Hamas, the label was sustained. Last year, ISNA's Canadian partner lost its status as a charity because of its connections with Pakistani terrorists and inconsistent accounting issues.

In April 2013, the Clarion Project said that the United States Air Force Chaplain Corps had paid ISNA almost \$5,000 for two advertisements in its magazine. When the Air Force was asked about ISNA's connections to the Brotherhood, they stated: "The Islamic Society of North America is one of many religious organizations recognized by the Department of Defense that satisfy the ecclesiastical requirements to endorse qualified religious ministry professionals to serve as chaplains within the Military Departments."
