The Legend of Betsy Ross



Many people know at least a little about Betsy Ross, the supposed maker of the nation's first flag. Ever since Ross' grandson, William Canby, first related his family's story of the flag's origins in an 1870 talk to the Historical Society of Pennsylvania, generations of Americans have heard how George Washington stepped into her Philadelphia shop on the eve of independence. He held a sketch in his hand for a new flag to represent the colonies united in the rebellion against England - 13 red and white stripes alongside a blue canton with a "new constellation" of 13 stars.



Parmesan Cookies

16 tablespoons unsalted butter, softened1 3/4 cups all-purpose flour2 cups finely grated Parmigiano-Reggiano cheese

- 1. Preheat the oven to 350°F; position the racks in the upper and lower third of the oven. Line two rimmed baking sheets with Silpat mats or parchment paper.
- 2. In the bowl of a stand mixer fitted with the paddle attachment, combine the butter, Parmigiano-Reggiano, and flour, and beat on low speed until a stiff dough forms. For a few minutes, the dough will look dry and will not come together; keep mixing, and you will see it form. Divide the dough into three pieces, and roll each piece into a 9-inch log, about VA inches in diameter. Wrap each log tightly in plastic wrap, and refrigerate for about 1 hour—this will make slicing it much easier. Alternatively, if making this ahead, you can freeze the dough for up to 2 months-just let it sit for 15 minutes at room temperature before slicing.
- 3. Slice the logs into Vs-inch-thick rounds, and arrange them on the prepared sheet pans about 2 inches apart. Bake the cookies for 15 to 18 minutes, or until they turn golden brown around the edges, shifting and rotating the pans halfway through baking for even browning. Let the cookies cool on the pans for 10 minutes before transferring them to a wire rack to cool completely. The cookies can be stored in an airtight container at room temperature for up to 5 days.

NOTE: Please take care to use real Parmigiano-Reggiano and not a domestic imitation. Because the cheese is one-third of the ingredients, it is imperative that it's high quality.

Hillary Clinton to Focus on Gun Control The Very First Day



In this year's presidential campaign, Hillary Clinton has revealed her contempt for our firearm freedoms with shocking candor, displaying a level of anti-gun sentiment unlike anything we've seen before in presidential politics. At an MSNBC "town hall" gathering in April, Clinton told the audience, "I really support everything President [Barack] Obama said he would do

through regulation on guns, but we're going to start the very first day and tackle the gun lobby." Later, Clinton said of gun control generally, "So I think that it's the kind of issue you have to start early, you have to work on it every day." Violent crime is at historic lows and gun ownership is at historic highs, but

Hillary Clinton has referred to the NRA and its members as, "the enemy." And if she gets the power, she will try to destroy everything we stand for.

Clinton would have you believe the "regulation of guns" demands the president's attention every single day, starting on "the very first day." When taken alongside other Clinton comments made during the long presidential primary season, the gravity of the threat, along with her dedication to the anti-gun cause, is clear.

At a fundraiser in New York City last September, Clinton remarked, "The Supreme Court is wrong on the Second Amendment, and I am going to make that case every chance I get." Clearly, Clinton does not believe that the Second Amendment protects an individual right to keep and bear arms, and she would seek to replace Antonin Scalia with a jurist who shares her erroneous interpretation. Scalia, of course, authored the landmark District of Columbia v. Heller opinion that recognized an individual right to keep and bear arms under the Second Amendment.

Even more ominous, Clinton endorsed an Australian-style gun ban scheme to confiscate firearms from law-abiding Americans during a campaign event in October. Of the Australian confiscation program, Clinton said, "I think it would be worth considering ... on the national level if that could be arranged."
