ONE LIFE TO GIVE

Introduction: There was an advertisement the other day about a show called The Walking Dead that made me think of how many people literally were wasting their life. They waste a precious life and usually come to a conclusion before death, "Only one life to give." But to whom are they giving it? What I am trying to say is that most live their life like the Walking Dead. When they die, very little is said of what they believed or how they lived.

FIRST: THE WORDS OF PAUL.

PHILIPPIANS 1:21

"For to me to live is Christ and to die is gain."

Paul the Apostle preached and practiced the belief that life was precious, and it was to be used for a greater cause than self. He believed his life was to be used for the One Who gave His all for him: the Lord Jesus Christ.

John 14:6, "I am the way the truth and the life."

Matthew 10:39, "He that findeth his life shall lose it and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it."

SECOND: THE EXAMPLE SET BY A PATRIOT.

When I was a little boy I remember the first time a teacher taught of that great American patriot Nathan Hale.

Nathan Hale came from a family of twelve children. His family lived and farmed in Coventry, Connecticut.

At the age of 14, Nathan was allowed to attend Yale College. Yale provided a great education with its main purpose to train young people to serve as ministers of Christ.

After graduation from Yale College, Nathan became a devout Christian school teacher and appointed the Master of Union school.

In 1774 Nathan joined the militia because of what he and others could see coming: war! Within months, he was promoted to 1st Sergeant. After the war broke out, Nathan received a letter from an old classmate, Benjamin Tallmadge.

It was Tallmage that encouraged Nathan to become an officer and to use his talents to spy on the enemy for General Washington. After the British drove Washington's forces out of Manhattan, the general asked Lieutenant Hale if he

Men say that some things are "as certain as death." Well, the coming of every condemned sinner to stand in judgment before God is one of the things that are as certain as death. The Scripture links them together. "It is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the

judgment" (Heb. 9: 27). Man cannot get by with sin. The Scripture says, "Be sure your sin will find you out" (Num. 32: 23). With all the reaping of sorrow that sin causes in this world, you may be sure that the penalty for sin has not yet been paid, has not probed to the depth of its wickedness, and that the fruitage, the bitter, the tragic, eternal, hellish fruitage of sin has not been brought to light in this life. No, men must stand before God and be judged for their sin. Unsaved men, condemned men, doomed men, men who will have already tasted the torments of the damned in Hell, these men and women and children must stand before God in judgment.

Then, out of the closet of the dead past will come the grinning, horrible skeletons of past sins, to face and condemn every sinner. Skeletons must all come out of their closets, and chickens must come home to roost, in the language of old proverbs.

Warning after warning has fallen from the mouth of God to sinners about judgment and the result of sin. We are warned, "Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap!" (Gal. 6:7). We well know that man does not do all his reaping in this life. No, God has yet a trump card to play. God will yet call men, unsaved, unrepentant, unregenerate men, to judgment. There they will reap what they sow, receive their just and public sentence, and depart to a lake of fire and a Christless, hopeless, peaceless eternity.

"The wages of sin is death," Romans 6:23. Does any man doubt it? Yea, but the wages are worse than you know. The death is more terrible than you dreamed—a living death, a death of condemnation and torment, a soul forsaken by the Spirit of God, his body condemned to a lake of fire! And the last judgment of the unsaved dead will simply be payday for sinners.

"Okay, We'll Go"

At 3:30 a.m. on June 5, 1944, Ike gathered his team together for a final decision. He asked each man for his opinion, and as he listened he paced the room. Captain Stagg had cautiously better news. He thought there might be a clearing. Ike felt a little bit better, but the weight of the fateful decision belonged solely to him. Finally he made it: "Okay, we'll go."

It was on. The order of the day, which Ike had been drafting for weeks, was distributed to the forces:

Gen. Dwight Eisenhower

Soldiers, Sailors and Airmen of the Allied Expeditionary Forces:

You are about to embark upon the Great Crusade, toward which we have striven these many months. The eyes of the world are upon you. The hopes and prayers of liberty-loving people everywhere march with you. In company with our brave Allies and brothers-in-arms on other Fronts you will bring about the destruction of the German war machine, the elimination of Nazi tyranny over oppressed peoples of Europe, and security for ourselves in a free world. ... Good Luck! And let us all beseech the blessing of Almighty God upon this great and noble undertaking.

Comment: Ike became the father of our great Interstate Highway System and one of the greatest presidents in history. When he was buried, he wanted to be remembered as a soldier and not as a political president. He was buried in his full dress army uniform.

would be willing to work undercover in New York. Hale agreed to do so.

While in New York, Nathan was advised to contact an ally Major Robert Rogers. However it turned out that Rogers was a spy for the British. When he met with Rodgers, Hale was arrested and taken to General Howe's headquarters. There he was questioned over and over, but refused to give any information about General Washington's army or their location.

On September 22nd, at the age of 21, Nathan Hale was taken out to be hanged. He requested only one thing: that he be given a Bible to read before his execution. The British refused his request.

On a chilly morning under a large tree witnesses described what occurred. Nathan Hale was asked, "Do you have any last words before your execution is carried out?" His reply was, "I only regret that I have but one life to give for my country."

THIRD: THE PLEA OF THE APOSTLE PETER.2 PETER 3:17-18

"... beloved ... beware, lest ye also ... fall from your own steadfastness." Do not waste your life. Do not be one of the walking dead, but come alive for Christ.

Matthew 24:37-39, "... as the days of Noe ... they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage ... and knew not until the flood came, and took them all away ..."

When a person dies, there is no walking dead. There is only Heaven or Hell. *Luke 16:23, "And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments."*

<u>Conclusion</u>: Dear reader, it is my duty to make you aware that you only have one life to give. No one can make you live for Christ, but Christ is the way of life and not death.

In *Joshua 24:15*, we see a father that boldly made a choice for his entire family. He said to all willing to listen, "*As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord.*"

U.S. Couple Trumpets Global Goodness on Bike Trek; ISIS Kills Them

Jay Austin and Lauren Geoghegan, both 29, quit their Washington, D.C., jobs a little over a year ago and embarked on a bicycle trip around the world. By April, their journey well underway, Austin wrote in the couple's blog...that they were embracing something beyond a mere great adventure.

"You watch the news and you read the papers and you're led to believe that the world is a big, scary place," he wrote. "People, the narrative goes, are not to be trusted. People are bad. People are evil. People are axe murderers and monsters and worse. ... I don't buy it. Evil is a make-believe concept we've invented to deal with the complexities of fellow humans holding values and beliefs and perspectives different than our own—it's easier to dismiss an opinion as abhorrent than strive to understand it. Badness exists, sure, but even that's quite rare. By and large, humans are kind—self-interested sometimes, myopic sometimes, but kind. Generous and wonderful and kind. No greater revelation has come from our journey than this."

Austin and Geoghegan were killed July 29—just a few days into the second year of their journey—in what CBS News said was an ISIS-inspired attack as they rode through Tajikistan, which is predominantly Muslim and borders Afghanistan.

A car rammed into the couple and other bicycle tourists, after which five men exited the vehicle and attacked the group with knives, the network reported. Two other bicyclists—one from the Netherlands and one from Switzerland—also were killed.
