You can see plainly that the "*fire*", the "*torment*", the crying out for "*mercy*", for relief, are absolutely taught in the Word of God, by Jesus Christ Himself.

Illustration: Years ago in Gadsden, Alabama, I knew a Christ rejecter who had been a profane, bitter and drunken man most of his life. I witnessed to him, but he said he had heard all that before. I was there in the hospital when he died. He screamed over and over, "I'm going to Hell! I'm going to Hell! Someone help me!" Then he died.

SECOND: HELL IS A PLACE OF SHAME.

If you read the whole passage you would discover that the man who died and went to Hell was revealed to be a man without compassion or concern for the hurting. Here was a man wealthy enough to help those in need, yet he closed his ears, stopped his conscience, and ignored the hurting.

Hell will always be a place where everyone is dishonored and there is no place to hide a past. Shame will be a 24/7 weight to bear.

Revelation 20:12, "And the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works."

Revelation 20:15, "And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the Lake of fire."

THIRD: HELL IS A PLACE OF AWAKENED SENSES.

He could see. He could feel. He could speak. He could thirst. He could remember.

Crust

2 cups graham cracker crumbs (from 14 graham crackers) 2 tbsp. granulated sugar 1 stick unsalted butter, melted

1.25-oz. envelope unflavored gelatin 1 8-oz. bar cream cheese, at room temperature

Kim Kline's Pumpkin Cheesecake

- 1 15-oz. can pumpkin puree 1 cup sour cream
- 3/4 cup granulated sugar
- 2 tsp. pumpkin pie spice
- 1 tsp. pure vanilla extract

Make the crust: Heat oven to 400° F. In a medium bowl, combine the graham cracker crumbs, sugar, and butter. Transfer to a 9-inch springform pan. Using a straight-sided dry measuring cup, press the mixture into the bottom and 2 inches up the sides of the pan. Bake until set, 8 to 10 minutes. Let cool.

Make the filling: sprinkle the gelatin over 1/4 cup boiling water. Let stand, stirring occasionally, until dissolved, about 5 minutes.

Using an electric mixer, beat the cream cheese until smooth. Mix in the pumpkin, sour cream, sugar, pumpkin pie spice, and vanilla. Mix in the gelatin mixture until incorporated.

Chill: Pour the mixture into the crust and refrigerate, covered, until firm, at least 2 hours and up to 2 days.

When I was in college, I met a group of people who were worldly-wise. They loved to party, drink, stay out late, and do whatever they pleased. I had never lived like this, as I grew up in a very conservative home.
