FIRST: THE AUTHOR OF MARRIAGE.

MARK 10:6-7 "But from the beginning of the creation God made them male and female. For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother and cleave to his wife..."

From the first marriage in the garden of Eden until now God has been the Author of marriage. Many believe marriage is just a contract between a man and a woman, but it is much deeper than that. Instead, marriage is a divine covenant with God.

Illustration: Today we see marriage as no better than trading our automobile. We get married and pot a new and better smelling model.

"Love, honor, cherish ... til death do us part," means today: Until we have our first argument.

SECOND: THE APPROVAL OF MARRIAGE.

"And the third day there was a marriage in Cana of Galilee; and the mother of Jesus was there; And both Jesus was called and His disciples, to the marriage."

You will find that Jesus is attending and putting his hand of approval on marriage in this passage. Notice: Hebrews 13:4, "Marriage is honourable in all, and the bed undefiled: but whoremongers and adulterers God will judge."

Meaning: Those who do it their way, without a covenant with God, are already under the judgement of God.

THIRD: THE APPEAL OF MARRIAGE.

"For this cause a man shall leave his father and his mother and cleave to his wife."

There is something so real, so overwhelming in the life of a young couple in love that they just know, "I can't live without you."

Illustration: When I was a young college student, I dated the most beautiful Italian girl that God ever created. One day it dawned on me that I could not live without her. Do not miss this, we had become the best of friends before I came to this conclusion.

FOURTH: THE AWARENESS OF MARRIAGE

Kim Kline's Old-Fashioned Soft Pumpkin Cookies

1 tsp baking soda 1 tsp baking powder 1 tsp ground cinnamon 1/2 tsp ground nutmeg 1/2 teaspoon salt 1 1/2 cups granulated sugar

1/2 cup butter (1 stick), softened1 cup Pure Pumpkin1 large egg1 tsp vanilla extract

i isp varinia extract

<u>Glaze</u> 2 cups sifted powdered sugar 3 tbsp milk 1 tbsp. melted butter

1 tsp vanilla extract

Preheat oven to 350° F. Grease baking sheets. Combine flour, baking soda, baking powder, cinnamon, nutmeg and salt in medium bowl. Beat sugar and butter in large mixer bowl until well blended. Beat in pumpkin, egg and vanilla extract until smooth. Gradually beat in flour mixture. Drop by rounded tablespoon onto prepared baking sheets. Bake for 15 to 18 minutes or until edges are firm. Cool on baking sheets for 2 minutes; remove to wire racks to cool completely.

For Glaze: Stir glaze ingredients in small bowl until smooth. Drizzle Glaze over cookies.

MARK 10:9

"What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder."

Asunder means: Divide, separate, to take apart.

You see, because God is the one Who ordains marriage, it is God only that can put asunder a marriage. No court, no judge, no man and no woman can put asunder what God has joined together.

Notice: Matthew 5:31-32, "...whosoever shall put away his wife, saving for the cause of fornication, causeth her to commit adultery: an whosoever shall marry her that is divorced committeth adultery."

As you can see, marriage is to be an absolute.

Conclusion: I am so thankful that God allowed me to be in a stable home. May I challenge you to renew your vow, "*til death do us part.*"

Married couples! Please give your children something to hang on to. Beg God to help your children see in you that Marriage still works and God is the One that glues it together. Children should not go to bed in fear every night weeping worried about dad and mom.

The call to preach is not something that should produce pride, but instead a humble acceptance of a sacred grace given. It is also something for which you must prepare. I Timothy 3:1-7, "This is a true saying, If a man desire the office of a bishop, he desireth a good work. A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach; Not given to wine, no striker, not greedy of filthy lucre; but patient, not a brawler, not covetous; One that ruleth well his own house, having his children in subjection with all gravity; (For if a man know not how to rule his own house, how shall he take care of the church of God?) Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of the devil. Moreover he must have a

good report of them which are without; lest he fall into reproach and the snare of the devil."

As a young man, called into the Gospel ministry, your entire focus during these young man years is to develop the character traits that will qualify you to fulfill your calling. Study the above list along with what is added in *Titus 1:5-9*. Understand the Bible definition of each qualifying trait. These are not suggestions, they are qualifications! Until your character so aligns, you remain unqualified to fulfill your calling. After Bible college, work under a senior pastor. Be an Elisha to some Elijah. Serve him, learn from him

From our Pastor's Wife ... Mrs. Vida Collingsworth The Trials Of Faith

Before going off to college, my pastor wisely said to me, 'Do not be surprised if, before you graduate, you face a trial (or trials).' Just days before leaving for college, my church went through a split. Oh, how my heart was saddened to see this occur--I loved all parties involved; but Jesus taught me through that trial to stand for the Man of God, and to stand for truth. It proved to be a very valuable lesson to this future pastor's wife!

Then, just months before graduating from Hyles-Anderson College (and while on my honeymoon), I had a reaction to medication that caused my mouth and the side of my face to be twisted. Dr. Streeter told me the medication caused a stroke. Here I was, a brand new bride, with only one semester left before I finished school, and my face was all

twisted. To make matters worse, people were saying that my husband did it.

'Would my face stay like this?' I found I couldn't sing, and wondered how I would be able to do my student teaching. In my heart I wanted to hide, embarrassed by my physical appearance, and concerned that my wonderful husband was now saddled with more than he bargained for. It all seemed rather gloomy. What was I to do?

I had two choices: #1-to quit, and feel sorry for myself; or #2-to go on. I decided to go on. I continued to go soulwinning, and continued to attend church. I had to die to self. I could not allow myself to dwell on my physical appearance. I did not know if this condition would last or not. This truly was a trial like I had never known before, but it taught me to trust in the Lord more than ever-to rejoice in Him.

The Bitterness Of Backsliding

Verse 20 says, "And she said unto them, Call me not Naomi, call me Mara: for the Almighty hath dealt very bitterly with me." She did not say, "For the preacher hath dealt very bitterly with me." She did not say, "For the Sunday school teacher hath dealt very bitterly with me." She did not say, "Mom and dad have dealt very bitterly with me." She said, "The Almighty God hath dealt very bitterly with me."

The first truth to understand is that God deals with every believer who flees to Moab. A child of God, saved by the blood of Jesus, who leaves the will of God, the house of God, and the Word of God for Moab, has a promise from the Scriptures that the Almighty Himself is going to deal with him. The Almighty Himself is going to scourge him. The Almighty Himself is going to be the One Who meets him face-to-face. He will not need

to worry about the pastor getting on his case anymore, because God Himself is going to deal with him. He will not need to worry about his Christian mom and dad lecturing him anymore, because the Almighty God Himself is going to deal with him. Mara here, or Naomi as she was known, did not come back with the arrogance or the pompous attitude of "I'm going to do whatever I want to do." because once she dealt with the Almighty, she had no pride or arrogance. When a person deals with the Almighty God, it is a very personal thing. She said, "The Almighty hath dealt very bitterly with me."

Every teenager and every young person who wants to leave all the rules of mom and dad needs to pay attention. If a teen wants to leave the things of God, God will deal with him personally. If a church member gets tired of the preaching of the Word of God and gets tired of the things the Holy Spirit presses upon him to change in his life and he says, "I want to get out of here," look out!

Notice how rock stars and movie stars really do not age that well. Why is that? It is because they have given themselves to the depravity of this world. The people Naomi knew and who loved her did not even recognize her when she came back. It never works out the way we think it is going to work. By her own admission, Naomi went out full and the Lord brought her home empty.

> Lest We Forget Remembering D-Day

When I say it exceeded my expectations, that doesn't even come close to describing the experience. What really brought it all home to me was when I visited that cemetery and saw what seemed like a sea of tombstones. The Normandy American Cemetery and Memorial, located at Colleville-sur-Mer. It overlooks what has become known as Omaha Beach and is the final resting place for 9,388 American military personnel. I basically stood in the right rear corner of the cemetery and panned, by video, all the way from left to right. The tombstones go all the way out of view, all the way from here and all the way to there – it really has a profound impact on you, you know? Walking up to the cemetery, going above the heights of Omaha Beach you think back to 1944 when that whole area was full of landing crafts and battleships, tanks and jeeps, and soldiers. The beaches were covered; and there were bodies everywhere. But you look at it now and it's so peaceful, it's so beautiful. Normandy is a beautiful place, an absolutely beautiful place. You contrast that with the history, and it has a profound effect on you. It really makes you think.



Some food for thought ...or... Seed From The Silo

Schoolchildren in China Taught to "Hate God," Christianity an "Evil Cult"

Christian parents in China have shared how their schoolchildren are being taught that Christianity is an "evil cult" and encouraged to "hate God" as the officially atheist country continues to tighten its grip on religion.

... Since the Regulations on Religious Affairs legislation was implemented last year, schools around China have adopted "unprecedented measures" to keep students away from Christianity. Schools in China are government-controlled and therefore communist in ideology.

The policy has resulted in difficult situations for families as children are encouraged to question the beliefs of family members and report those closest to them to authorities...

"Before starting school, I told my child about God's creation and he believed it," the woman explained. "But after being taught at school, my child is like a different person. In atheistic China, these pure and innocent children have been taught to hate God."

Kindergarten and primary schools are also teaching children how to oppose religion. In late April, a primary school in Xinzheng city in the central province of Henan encouraged young children to refrain from believing in any deity...

Another school screened a propaganda video in which Jesus followers were depicted as big, scary monsters. After the presentation was complete, a teacher warned that Christian relatives might "cast spells" on the youngsters...

Other students were advised to "supervise" their parents to ensure that they don't practice their faith.

China introduced revised regulations on religion in February, which included banning under-18s from attending church or receiving any religious education.

The new regulations have also forced primary schools in Henan to warn parents that they are not allowed to breach the country's laws on the practice of religion.

Disney Channel Introduces Its First Gay Teen Romance

Disney Channel series Andi Mack has made history by depicting the network's first teenage gay couple. The season three finale of the series, which aired July 26, concluded with the scene between Cyrus Goodman ... confessing his attraction to his classmate TJ Kippen ...

The homosexual declaration was made in the episode along with another scene in which the pair sang along to Lady Gaga's LGBT anthem "Born This Way."

In 2017 Disney announced that the show's second season would begin showing Cyrus Goodman's "self discovery" path. The series was not renewed for a fourth season. While this was Disney's first depiction of a teen same-sex relationship, the first same-sex adult couple in a Disney show for kids occurred in 2014 on Good Luck Charlie ...

The multinational mass media and entertainment company has been slowly adopting and promoting LGBT views, as seen on its television shows and movies such as Beauty and the Beast and Doc McStuffins in 2018. In 2017 Star vs. the Forces of Evil introduced the company's first male princess on the same show that previously drew controversy for featuring the first same-sex kisses.

The child-geared enterprise will also feature an openly gay role in its upcoming live-action film, Jungle Cruise.

The question of women preachers is settled by the Bible. First, it is the uniform practice of both the Old and the New Testament that God did not call women preachers. There were no women apostles, no women pastors, no women evangelists in the Bible. And second, the Scripture expressly teaches: "Let your women keep silence in the churches: for it is not permitted unto them to speak" (I Cor. 14:34). And again, "Let the woman learn in silence with all subjection. But I suffer not a woman to teach, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence" (I Tim. 2:11, 12).

We "moderns" feel that we know so many ways to do the Lord's business that are better than His ways. But when Nadab and Abihu went into the tabernacle, carrying strange fire, not the appointed fire, they were stricken dead by an angry God (*Lev. 10:1, 2*). When David brought the ark up to Jerusalem on an oxcart instead of the Lord's way, he had trouble, and

death struck the man who touched the ark (*II Sam. 6:6,7*). And even when the good king Uzziah went into the temple to offer sacrifice, where it was forbidden for anybody but the priest, God struck him with leprosy (*II Chron. 26:16-21*). And when Miriam the prophetess wanted to usurp authority

struck him with leprosy (*II Chron. 26:16-21*). And when Miriam the prophetess wanted to usurp authority in religious work, wanted to take a place of leadership like some men had, God struck her with leprosy for her sin (*Num. 12:10*). And so today there is a curse, a plague of an angry God on churches because we do things our own way instead of the way of God.
