

Lest We Forget



Born in West Germany to a military family, Emily Jazmin Tatum Perez understood from an early age what it meant to serve her country. Less than a month into her first semester at the U.S. Military Academy at West Point, the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001, occurred. Shouldering the weight of history, these cadets would become known as the "Class of 9/11." In addition to being an exemplary student and talented athlete, Emily became the first female minority Cadet Command Sergeant Major in the history of the Academy.

Perez graduated from West Point in 2005 and was commissioned as a second lieutenant in the 204th Support Battalion, 2d Brigade, 4th Infantry Division. During her first deployment to Iraq as a Medical Services Corps officer, Perez was killed in action on September 12, 2006.

Upon her death, Perez became the first graduate of the West Point "Class of 9/11" to die in combat and the first female graduate to die in the war in Iraq. Additionally, Perez became the first female African-American officer in the history of the Army to die in combat.

University Purges Pledge of Allegiance for Not Being Inclusive

A vote to stop reciting the Pledge of Allegiance during meetings was cast by the Grand Valley State University (GVSU) Student Senate - with twice as many voting to remove it than keep it--as the overwhelming majority insisted the patriotic tribute symbolizes an oppressive and discriminatory government that is noninclusive.
