Psalm 100:4, "Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and in his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name.'

DEUTERONOMY 28:1

Benjamin Rush said of him, just before the signing of the Declaration of Independence, Samuel Adams spoke to him and said, "If it were revealed to me that nine hundred Americans out of every thousand will perish in a war for liberty, I would vote for that war rather than see my country enslaved. The survivors of such a war, though few, would propagate a nation of free men."

Prayer of Salvation


If you were to die today, are you 100% sure you would go to Heaven? If not, would you be willing to pray this prayer with me?

"In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you." (I Thessalonians 5:18)

(Job 1:21)

A Chinese virologist who escaped to the United States earlier this year claims the coronavirus is manmade
