SHALL RENEW THEIR STRENGTH"

Introduction: The wonderful thing about serving God is that even when we become tired and discouraged, He renews us. When things seem hopeless, He gives us new hope.

Lost sinners can be born again and become new in Christ and start life afresh and new.

The backslidden who have fallen and stumbled can be used again.

Allow me to reveal how God renews by using different stories in the

FIRST: HE HAS THE POWER TO RENEW OUR SPIRIT.

"Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me."

David had committed horrible sins. He not only took someone else's wife but tried to cover t up by having her husband, Uriah, killed in battle. (II Samuel 11 and 12).

After he was approached by God's man, he sought forgiveness from God. His biggest problem, however, was the condition of his spirit. It was seared and damaged horribly. What does he do? He goes to God in prayer and asks not only for forgiveness, but that his spirit be renewed and made right again.

What did God do? God forgave and renewed.

SECOND: HE HAS THE POWER TO RENEW A NATION.

I SAMUEL 11:14

"Then said Samuel to the people, come and let us go to Gilgal, and renew the kingdom... Every nation that reaches out to God will find themselves surrounded by enemies.

In *I Samuel 11*, the nation of Israel was in trouble. They were rejected God's rule for a king. They wanted to be like all the other nations. Regardless, they belong to God, and God always shows mercy to those who are willing to reach out to Him.

Samuel called for the people to assemble at Gilgal and renew the kingdom. God heard them, eceived their heart-felt sacrifices, and renewed them and gave them great victory.

II Chronicles 7:14, "If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land."

THIRD: HE HAS THE POWER TO RENEW HIS OWN.

ISAIAH 40:31

"But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint."

Even the strongest and the best of God's own eventually grow weary. Disappointments, heartaches, grief, betrayal, personal failures, fear; all can drain us of our strength.

Elijah became so weak after a great victory that he wanted to die. But, even in the worst of times, God is there to strengthen those who are willing to call upon Him.

Renewal always comes from waiting upon God. When our strength and zeal are gone and we ust think we can go no farther, that is when we need to get alone with God and

The Whole Armor


A new recruit joins the Army. Before he is given a weapon, he is given a uniform. Before he faces the enemy, he is given a uniform. He will never graduate boot camp without the proper uniform. Long before he feels like a soldier, he is told to dress like one. He puts on the boots, the uniform, the helmet, and all the protective gear as he prepares himself for battle. He has not yet faced the enemy. He has not yet even discovered how dangerous the enemy is. He wears the uniform as he is preparing.

Eventually, there comes a time for battle. When that soldier faces the enemy, he becomes aware of just how dangerous that enemy is. At that point, he does more than just put on his uniform and equipment. He takes it up himself. It

becomes his decision and his personal responsibility. No one needs to tell him because he knows the danger he is facing. He is in the midst of battle! There is a distinct difference between someone "putting on" the whole armor of God and someone "taking unto him" the whole armor of God.

We are commanded to put on the whole armor of God. We should do so out of obedience; but when we get a better understanding of the enemy we are facing, we must go from putting it on to taking it up. Knowing the enemy is the difference maker. It becomes more than an act of obedience. It becomes an act of necessity. It becomes our responsibility. In *Ephesians 6:13*, it is important to note that Paul preceded the statement, "...take unto you the whole armour of God," with the word "Wherefore" which indicates that he was basing his point on what he had just said. In verse 12, Paul explained, "For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places."

Perhaps many Christians remain vulnerable because they never become fully aware of the danger they face. As we discuss the various parts of the Christian's armor, we must recognize the two aspects given in this passage. We put it on because of obedience. We take it up because of understanding. When we are aware of the dangers we face, we are more likely to take responsibility for wearing the whole armor of God.

How to Read the Bible

That great prayer warrior, George Mueller, tells us how to read the Word of God.

- "1. Read the Scriptures regularly through. Read, alternately, portions from the Old and New Testaments. Begin at the beginning of each. Mark where you leave off, and begin there next time. When you have finished each Testament, begin it again.
- "2. Read with prayer. You cannot by your own wisdom understand the Word of God. In all your reading of the Scriptures, seek carefully the help of the Holy Spirit. Ask for Jesus' sake that He will enlighten you.
- "3. Read with meditation. Ponder over what you read. The truth is thus applied to your heart. You see new and deeper meanings. It is better to think over a little than merely to read a great deal.
- "4. Read with reference to yourself. Never read only with a view to instructing others, but for your own teaching. Receive blessings yourself first, and you will communicate it to others. Always ask yourself, 'How does this affect me?'
- "5. Read with faith. Not as statements which you may believe or not but as the revealed word of God. Receive every word as true, with simple, childlike trust. Rest upon the promises. Read them as made for you.
- "6. Read in order to carry into practice. We must accept His Word as being the revelation of His will. In it He tells us what to be and what to do. He expects us to be 'obedient children'."

Lest We Forget



Technical Sgt. Charles Coolidge receives the Medal of Honor from Army Lt. Gen. Wade Haislip on June 18, 1945 Coolidge died April 6, four months shy of his 100th birthday. He was the nation's oldest living Medal of Honor recipient and a 77-year member of The American Legion.

A book binder for his family's engraving and printing business, Coolidge entered the Army in 1942. He fought in North Africa, Italy, France and Germany, and was awarded the Silver Star for his actions at Velletri in May 1944.

In October 1944, near Belmont-sur-Buttant, Coolidge led an inexperienced and isolated group of soldiers under fire from German infantry. Outnumbered 4 to 1, the tech sergeant and his men repelled attacks for three days, until an enemy tank rolled within 30 yards of their position. From the turret, a soldier

called in English, "Want to give up?"

Looking him in the face, Coolidge replied, "I'm sorry, Mac, you've gotta come and get me."

He dodged five shots from the tank and began tossing grenades after his bazooka failed, killing some 20

Germans before coordinating a withdrawal. For his actions, he received the nation's highest award for valor.

Seed From The Silot

Democrats Introduce New Bill to Eliminate Every Single Pro-Life Law Nationwide

Senate Democrats have introduced a new bill that would eliminate every single pro-life law nationwide.

The so-called Women's Health Protection Act "would invalidate nearly all existing state limitations on abortion," said Jennifer Popik, director of federal legislation for National Right to Life.

"This legislation would also prohibit states from adopting new protective laws in the future, including various types of laws specifically upheld as constitutionally permissible by the U.S. Supreme Court," she said.

Carol Tobias, president of National Right to Life, said the measure "would essentially remove all legal protections for unborn children on the federal and state level. The Women's Health Protection Act is, in effect, a no-limits-on-abortion-until-birth bill."

"Tragically, the only ones to benefit from such a law would be abortionists and abortion providers such as Planned Parenthood," she added. "This legislation endangers women and their unborn children, would expand taxpayer funding of abortion and would no longer require that a woman be given information about the development of her unborn child."

Judge Orders Teacher Who Opposes Trans Pronouns Be Reinstated by School District

A judge has ordered a Virginia school district to reinstate an elementary school teacher who was placed on leave after criticizing a proposed policy that would require him and other teachers to use the preferred names and pronouns of trans-identified students.

Byron Tanner Cross, a physical education teacher at Leesburg Elementary School, was put on administrative leave not long after he expressed his opposition to the proposed pronoun policy at a Loudon County School Board meeting...

...Judge James E. Plowman of the 20th Judicial Circuit of Virginia... wrote that putting Cross on leave was "extreme" and "an unconstitutional action" since the teacher's words, even if controversial, were nevertheless "permissible."

"The Court agrees with Plaintiff's analysis and concludes that Defendants' actions to suspend the plaintiff, as well as the additional restrictions placed upon him, adversely affected his constitutionally protected speech," wrote the judge.

What Kind Of Seed Are You Sowing?

Leadership



"Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of God: whose faith follow, considering the end of their conversation.... Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you." Hebrews 13:7, 17.

I begin with this suggestion: it would be wise first to seek counsel from the spiritual leadership in your life before entering into a courtship. This would make choosing whom to marry go much more smoothly.

Let's examine some statements from our Scripture text. First, consider the phrase, "Remember them which have the rule over you." The word "remember" as used here means that we are to be mindful of them, the things they have taught us and the investment they have made in our lives.

Second, who are those that "rule over" us? I submit that the three most important are our parents, our pastor and those who have taught us the Word of God, such as Sunday school teachers and youth directors, etc. These are the people who watch for our souls and have generally made the largest spiritual investment in our lives through teaching us prayer and love.

Third, observe the statement "considering the end of their conversation." The word "conversation" used here implies behavior. Webster's Dictionary gives us this definition: "General course of manners; behavior, deportment, especially as it respects morals." In making any important decision in our lives, we should consider the leadership God has put into our lives. The spiritual leader to consider in your life is your pastor. Now, I want to be very careful here. Let's say you are in college, and you have a pastor who has been a part of your life for a short amount of time; I think you should seek counsel from this pastor. However, I also believe it would be wise to seek counsel from the pastor you have had for the longest period of time. For example, it would be wise to seek the counsel of the pastor you had during your teen years because the pastor you have had the longest probably knows you better and has the most invested in your life. You should hold your pastor's counsel in very high regard; he is the man God has sent to you from His heart. "And I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and under standing" (Jeremiah 3:15).

As I look back on the marriages I have seen over the years, the ones that fared the best are the ones on which good godly pastors put their blessing."
