Introduction: It has always amazed me how that things revealed in the Word of God concerning science were laughed at by so-called scientists of that day, yet now we know the Bible was absolutely true. What I mean is that science catches up with the Bible not the other way around. Consider a few thoughts with me.

FIRST: THE SHADOW OF THE SUN.

JAMES 1:17

"...with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning."

"Shadow of turning" is an astronomy term. The Bible is saying that God is unchangeable in His character. In other words, God has no parallax. A parallax is an angle by which the size and distance of something can be measured. The sun casts a shadow, therefore it can be measured. God casts no shadow. Getting back to school after summer vacation is always a time of preparation and planning for teachers, students, and families.

As a teacher, for many years, I have had many opportunities to observe what makes a successful, happier year for all involved. It is the little things we do that will lead to accomplishment.

Being a saved person who has a daily personal relationship with the Lord in prayer and in their Bible is a given priority. But what next? Students, like adults, have many duties and responsibilities in their daily life other than school. Why do some succeed easier than others? It is not because some students are smarter. (I have seen academically smart people fail in life) It is because they pay attention to the little things. Daily routine is important. In the military one of the first things they teach you is to make your bed! Why, because you're starting the day taking care of little things. Brushing teeth, combing hair, making sure your attire is neat and pressed is important. You are making sure that you are ready to face the day.

Be organized. Keep your work and supplies neat and together. Staying organized should be a daily habit. Write down your daily goals – this will help keep you focused. Plan how you are going to accomplish what is on your list and get started. Don't try to take short cuts. <u>Students who half-read accomplish half as much!</u> Be diligent. Focus on one thing or subject at a time.

Read all instructions more than once and do any examples. Review- repetition is the key to all learning. Read aloud when possible.

Schedule your break time. After a set period of time you need to give yourself "Break time". This should be a short period of time where you get up, move around, eat a snack etc. Don't sit in front of the tv or play station for your few minutes will turn into hours. Keep this for when your work is done even if this means having to forgo this during school days. Don't rush through homework for other things. You will end up doing it twice as much and twice as long.

Put On The Helmet



Ephesians 6:17, "... the helmet of *salvation..."* As it was necessary to protect other parts of the body while in battle, it was

As it was necessary to protect other parts of the body while in battle, it was essential for a soldier to protect his head. If detail was taken in protecting the feet which, in comparison, is not as important as the head, it makes sense to give attention to this crucial part of the body. A soldier's helmet was essential for two reasons.

Dr. Greg Neal First, it protected him from head injuries. Head injuries were often fatal. The sword of an enemy had the capacity of inflicting two types of damage. It could deliver a blunt blow to the head, leaving a soldier defenseless and often leading to death. The other edge of the sword was sharp and could be used to sever the

head or to wound fatally. For that reason, helmets were constructed of metal and leather. Because of the extreme weight, the helmets were fitted tightly to a soldier's head. The helmet covered the neck and even some of the soldier's face.

Secondly, it identified him from other soldiers. Different helmets were worn depending on the soldier's position or duty. The helmet distinguished that soldier for his uniqueness. A soldier's helmet was personalized. Soldiers took great pride in customizing their helmets. They uniquely engraved them. Each of us has our own personal experience of coming to faith in Christ. It is our testimony. We must wear it on our heads in a personal way.
