"Make up your mind."

I Kings 18:21, "...How long halt ye between two opinions? If the Lord be God, follow him: but if Baal, then follow him. And the people answered him not a word."

For decades your pastor has been saying, "Know what you believe and why you believe it.'

FIRST: IT IS A CRITICAL CHOICE.

<u>I KINGS 18:21</u>

The word, "halt," carries with it the teaching of having specific problems. For instance, it means to "waver," "sway from side to side," "to limp along." God's people were crippled because of their double-minded attitude. They acted like modern day politicians swayed by the wind. They wanted the best of both worlds. They were not sold out to false religion, but they were not sold out to God either.

Their sin was expensive, as food and water were scarce. God's people were being crippled by their fence straddling! It was time to make up their mind.

If you want God's blessings, then get off the fence.

<u>SECOND: IT IS THE CALL OF CHAMPIONS.</u>

I SAMUEL 17:29

"Is there not a cause?"

When David came upon the battlefield, he could not believe what he was seeing. He saw two armies yet not one of his own people would consider the cause of battle.

I Samuel 17:3, "And the Philistines stood on a mountain on the one side, and Israel stood on the other side: and there <mark>was a vall</mark>ey between them."

Here are two opposing forces. If you noticed, there was a valley between them. That valley should always exist between right and wrong! It should be clearly seen. But, as you have noticed in society today, everyone wants to live in the valley.

Once a choice is made to be a valley dweller, then there will not be any obvious view of right and wrong. What will you see? Just the one view of the valley dwellers, that view is, "Can't we all just get along?"



Then when the majority is corrupt, and they repeal the laws against pornographic literature, divorce is made easy, and the majority begins to press for the right to murder unborn babies (abortion). Kim Kline's Pumpkin Cheesecake Filling

temperature

2 cups graham cracker crumbs 1 .25-oz. envelope 1 15-oz. can pumpkin puree (from 14 graham crackers) 2 tbsp. granulated sugar 1 stick unsalted butter, melted

Crust

unflavored gelatin

1 cup sour cream 1 8-oz. bar cream 3/4 cup granulated sugar cheese, at room 2 tsp. pumpkin pie spice

1 tsp. pure vanilla extract

Make the crust: Heat oven to 400° F. In a medium bowl, combine the graham cracker crumbs, sugar, and butter. Transfer to a 9-inch springform pan. Using a straight-sided dry measuring cup, press the mixture into the bottom and 2 inches up the sides of the pan. Bake until set, 8 to 10 minutes. Let cool.

Make the filling: sprinkle the gelatin over 1/4 cup boiling water. Let stand, stirring occasionally, until dissolved, about 5 minutes.

Using an electric mixer, beat the cream cheese until smooth. Mix in the pumpkin, sour cream, sugar, pumpkin pie spice, and vanilla. Mix in the gelatin mixture until incorporated.

Chill: Pour the mixture into the crust and refrigerate, covered, until firm, at least 2 hours and up to 2 days.
