Lest We Forget



Air Force Chief Master Sergeant Richard Etchberger

Etchberger was part of a secret mission directing air strikes against enemy targets in Laos and North Vietnam between 1967 and 1968.

The radar installation where Etchberger was assigned —Lima Site 87— had been equipped with a system that allowed him and his fellow technicians to direct bombings against the North Vietnamese in all kinds of weather and at night. When the North Vietnamese realized that American bombers were able to hit their targets in spite of heavy cloud cover, they realized that there must be a radar installation nearby. So they began closing in on Etchberger and his men. By March 11, the North Vietnamese had overrun the site, forcing Etchberger and the surviving men to take shelter down the slope of the mountain. Even though he had little to no combat training, Etchberger held off the approaching enemy with nothing more than an M-16 and sheer determination, all while directing air strikes, tending to the wounded, and calling for an air rescue to

evacuate them.

When the rescue helicopter arrived, Etchberger made sure all of his men were safely aboard before allowing himself to be hoisted up while enemy fire erupted around him.

All seemed fine when he got aboard. But then a bullet pierced through the helicopter's armor, striking Etchberger and killing him.

Because he died on classified mission, his family was told simply that he died in a helicopter crash. It wasn't until 14 years later, when his mission was declassified, that they learned the truth of what he'd done.

Although he was initially given the Air Force Cross, his award was later updated to the Medal of Honor and presented to his sons in 2010.

Richard Etchberger represents the 2.7 million men and women who were faithful to their oath and served their country with honor in Vietnam. Sadly, millions of young people don't know who he is.

2 strips thick bacon 3 large sweet potatoes, cut into quarters

1/4 cup olive oil Salt and pepper 1/2 cup sour cream

Kim Kline's Smashed Sweet Potatoes

4 oz. Cheddar cheese, grated Fresh chives

Cook bacon until crispy, either in a skillet or baked in the oven. Once the bacon is crispy, let cool and chop into bits for topping. Set aside. Preheat oven to 350°F. Cut off the ends of the sweet potatoes, then cut them into quarters. Pour olive oil on a baking sheet and rub potatoes on both sides to coat.

Sprinkle potatoes with salt and pepper. Bake potato pieces for 25-30 minutes until they are fork tender. Then let cool briefly until you can handle them. Use a small plate to smash each potato down a bit. Return smashed potatoes to baking sheet. Bake smashed potatoes a second time for 10 minutes to crisp them up a bit. Remove potatoes from oven and top with sour cream, shredded cheese, crispy bacon bits, and fresh chives.
