FIRST: PONDER ON THE WALK YOU HAVE.

PSALM 119:59

JEREMIAH 6:16

"I thought on my ways, and turned my feet unto thy testimonies."

The prophet Haggai urged the people in Haggai 1:5-7, "Consider your ways ... "

The question for you to ponder right now is whether or not your ways are taking you in the right direction.

It is not enough just to want to go in the right direction. Balaam said in *Numbers 23:10,* "Let me die the death of the righteous, and let my last end be like his."

But, after praying this prayer he turned and walked in the wrong direction. He died fighting against God.

It is so easy to be deceived. Proverbs 16:2-3, "Commit thy works unto the Lord, and thy thoughts shall be established."

The only way we can be sure that our walk is leading us in the way of God is to commit our ways unto Him, then our course in life will be established.

By the way, the Word of God is our Guide.

Proverbs 15:32, "He that refuseth instruction despiseth his own soul: but he that heareth reproof getteth understanding."

The Word of God will both commend us and criticize us to help us to stay in God's chosen path for us.

SECOND: PRAY FOR THE OLD WALK.

"Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths..."

The word "ask" is the same word for "pray." We are to pray for the old paths.

Every road leads to somewhere. That means that a road heavily used does not mean it's the right road. Many take the wrong road every day just because the majority travel that road.

TEARS OF HEAVEN



<u>Introduction:</u> There is so much false teaching on the subject of Tears in Heaven. Surely this needs to be clarified.

"... God shall wipe away ALL TEARS from their eyes." Rev. 21:4

Several years ago, an elderly Baptist preacher told me that there would never be any tears in Heaven. He said, "Son, there will not even be any tear ducts in our glorified bodies!"

Somehow the old preacher's words did not set well with me. I was just a "babe" in Christ at the time, but glorified bodies with no tear ducts just did not seem right.

The thought crossed my mind, Will we not be able to shed tears of joy when we see Jesus in Heaven, and meet our loved ones on the golden streets?

Then another: Will there be no tears of remorse at the Judgment Seat for Christians who lived carnally and wasted their lives?

And finally, another: Will the inhabitants in Heaven not weep at the White Throne Judgment when the lost are cast into the Lake of Fire?

I immediately went to the Scriptures. With all due respect to the dear old preacher ... he was WRONG! There WILL be tears in Heaven until AFTER the White Throne Judgment. Then ... "God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes." Rev. 21:4

If our new bodies had no tear ducts, then there would be no tears in our eyes to be WIPED AWAY! A careful look at Revelation Chapter 21 will reveal that the very LAST THING God does before He makes ALL THINGS NEW. and we settle down into our eternal state, is to WIPE AWAY ALL TEARS FROM OUR EYES (See *Rev. 21:4-5*).

The Lord Jesus knows all about our tears. He walked this earth as the Man of Sorrows (*Isaiah* 53:3). Many was the time when tears coursed their way down His tender cheeks.

Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. But when He saw the multitudes, He was MOVED WITH COMPASSION on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd. (*Matt. 9:35-36*)

"And He was come near, He beheld the city and WEPT over it." (Luke 19:41)

<u>Conclusion</u>: At the tomb of Lazarus, Jesus shed tears, feeling the heartache of Martha and Mary over their loss.

again, and that it will get you safely where God intended for you to be. John 14:6, "I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the father, but by me."

THIRD: PRACTICE THE WALK.

COLOSSIANS 2:6

"As ye therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in Him..." Hebrews 11:5, "By faith, Enoch...had this testimony, that he pleased God."

It is not enough just to have the knowledge of the walk God has for you, nor is it enough for you to admire others that have walked with God. The very purpose of the knowledge that God has a path for you to walk should cause each of us to make a determination to follow that road that God has revealed to us.

<u>Conclusion:</u> If you are reading this article right now, then you and you alone know whether or not you are on that path God has ordained for you. If so, right now, get up and walk. If you are at ease with not conviction about your spiritual condition, then you should be greatly alarmed. Busy with material things can distract you. Seek the Lord now while you have an opportunity. It is dangerous for you to gamble with eternity at stake. Come now while conviction is tugging at your heart.

I have been a licensed, ordained Baptist preacher for forty eight years. I have traveled over five million miles and preached over twenty-four thousand sermons in forty-eight states. Something has always intrigued me about the attacks of Satan on soul winning, fundamental Baptist churches. I have noticed, from time to time, a wave of a particular attack by Satan on many churches around our nation at the same time. For a few years we will see a wave of financial setbacks; in another few years, disloyalty among staff; in another few years; struggles with immorality, etc. Lately it seems that a wave of seemingly solid church members are losing their senses, leaving the men of God whom they have sat under for years and joining other churches in the same area.

In the last thirty days, I have received fifteen phone calls from pastors who have lost church members to other pastors in the same area. The new pastors never picked up the phone and

called the former pastor about the people transferring to their churches. Some preachers are so eager for growth that they do not care if these transfers are ethical or not. The result is a lack of ethical cooperation among men of God who are supposed to be leading their people in the battle for the souls of men, not a battle for transfers.

When the battles come, there are always a few cowards in every church who run from the battle and transfer their membership to another church. There are two temptations facing preachers who find them selves on the giving or receiving end of these transfers. One is the temptation to ease up on the standards and the soul winning. The other is the temptation to accept those who are running from the pastor who refuses to ease up in the battle for the souls of men, doing nothing to salvage a special relationship between pastor and people.

There is always a reason why people leave one ministry to go to another, and it is never the story they tell. It amazes me that these pastors can accept transfers without ever checking with the previous pastor. You may be taking in a thief, a child molester, a home wrecker, a homosexual, or a sexual deviant. Even the business world will check references. I would hate to think that Wal-Mart is more diligent to its cause than Baptist preachers are to the cause of Christ.

Recently, we like so many others across the world, were hit by a Covid Delta wave. (I called it a tsunami!). This started the end of October. Many of our members had Covid. Reading God's Word, time in prayer and the preaching of God's Word are always a help and comfort. I thank God for this and for using Mrs. Neal. She had no idea how God was using her to speak to my heart in song. I thank God He was reminding me that He would give me the grace that was needed for such a time as this.

Chicken Tortilla Soup

Season 6 bone-in, skin-on chicken stock thighs well with kosher salt and black pepper. In a large Dutch oven, heat 1 tablespoon olive oil over medium. Sear thighs skin sides down in hot oil until browned, about 6 minutes. Turn thighs and cook 4 minutes more. Transfer to a plate. Add the white ends of 6 green onions, the stems from 1 small

bunch cilantro, 3 smashed cloves garlic, 2 teaspoons whole coriander seeds and 1 teaspoon cumin seeds to pot; cook and stir until aromatic, 30 to 60 seconds. Add 3 stalks celery and 2 carrots, cut into big chunks; 1 coarsely chopped onion; and 1 small coarsely chopped jalapeño pepper. Return chicken to pot. Add 2 quarts water and 1 tablespoon kosher salt. Bring to a boil, reduce heat, cover and simmer 2 hours. Remove chicken and set aside to cool. Strain stock and skim fat. Seed the pepper for a mild soup or leave in all or some of the seeds for more heat.

Return pot to stove. Heat 2 tablespoons soup olive oil over medium. Add 1 cup chopped onion, 1 teaspoon kosher salt and 1/4 teaspoon black pepper; cook until tender and beginning to caramelize, 8 to 10 minutes. Add 1 clove grated garlic; cook 1 minute more. Add the stock and one 14.5-ounce can diced tomatoes, undrained. Bring to a boil and simmer 10 minutes. Use an immersion blender to puree soup, adding 3 to 7 torn corn tortillas until soup reaches desired thickness. Add 1 jicama, peeled and chopped, and 5 carrots, peeled and sliced; return to a boil. Simmer until vegetables are tender, about 10 minutes; remove from heat. Add chicken, removed from bones and torn into pieces. Serve soup with garnishes such as lime wedges, sliced radishes, sliced jalapeño peppers, quartered avocado, sliced green onions, chopped cilantro and/or fried tortilla strips.
