**Introduction:** I do not want you to misunderstand by my title, "Fall Revival." We need revival all the time, but I have noticed that many tend to drift from the Lord throughout the year. People begin by making vows and new year's resolutions, but by the Fall they are far from the position they once held.

"Wilt thou not revive us again: that thy people may rejoice in thee?" Revival has always been a convicting work by the Holy Spirit of Almighty God among His own people in order to get them both right

with God and with each other. Revival is not just larger attendance and increase in giving. How do we recognize the need of revival?

#### FIRST: WHEN THERE IS AN ABSENCE OF REJOICING.

PSALM 85:6

"...that thy people may rejoice in thee..."

It is obvious that the people had been joyful in the past, but now there is an absence. The joy of the Lord is missing.

Illustration: In Psalm 51:12, we read how the sweet psalmist of Israel is crying out, "Restore unto me the joy of they salvation." He did not say that he had lost his salvation, but his joy.

Why is this so important?

Notice: Nehemiah 8:10 says, "...for the joy of the Lord is your strength."

The absence of joy will always drain you of spiritual strength.

#### SECOND: WHEN THERE IS A FAILURE TO RECOGNIZE

"...Samson...wist not that the Lord was departed from him."

The presence of the Lord should be something we desire 24/7, yet even those who at one time felt the presence of God have allowed themselves to become so busy that they have not even noticed His departure.

Illustration: In I Samuel 4:21, Eli's daughter-in-law was giving birth to a child. She named him "Ichabod" because she new that God's presence had departed from Israel.

One of my greatest fears concerning America is that "I-cha-bod" has now been written across our land.

Church, remember, when was the last time you felt the presence of God in your life.

#### THIRD: WHEN THERE IS SIN WITHOUT REPENTANCE.

**LUKE 15:17** 

The prodigal son committed horrible sins. But allow me to share with you what was connected to his return.

- I. He came to himself. He actually recognized how foolish he was acting.
- II. He got up and went back to where he belonged. Luke 15:20


"Nick, what are you doing?

Two types of righteousness taught in the Bible:

- I. Imputed righteousness. *II Corinthians 5:21* What Christ does for you the minute you place your faith in Him.
- II. Practical righteousness This is the child of God practicing Bible truth in everyday living. It is faith in action.

Matthew 5:16, "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your father which is in Heaven."

People judge you by how you live. They go by what you do any say.

<u>Conclusion:</u> God is our Creator. That means we belong to Him. To the One that is holy, just and is the judge of what He has made.

God is also very gracious to what He has created. He demonstrates His amazing grace by His love, forgiveness, and His patience.

#### **Sweet Potatoe Delight**

4 pounds sweet potatoes 1/4 cup heavy cream
4 tablespoons butter, 1/4 cup honey melted 1/3 cup orange juice 1 tsp. orange zest 1 tsp. sea salt 1/4 cup firmly packed dark 1/4 tsp. ground nutmeg brown sugar 3/4 cup pecan halves

Preheat the oven to 350°F.

Peel, wash, and quarter the sweet potatoes. Place them in a stockpot, add enough water to cover them by 2 inches, and bring them to a boil. Continue boiling them until they are fork-tender, about 15 minutes. Drain, and transfer them to a large bowl.

Add the butter, cream, honey, orange juice, orange zest, brown sugar, salt, and nutmeg, and mash everything together with a potato masher or an electric mixer. Spoon the sweet potato mixture into a casserole dish, and top it with pecan halves. Bake it for 30 minutes. *Makes 8-10 servings*

# Bible Believers Are Confused About Separation II Corinthians 6:17

Separation from worldliness is not an end in itself; it is a means to an end. Separation is refraining from doing that which keeps us from doing what God intended for us to do. Separation is fixing the car, not so it can sit attractively in the garage, but so it can run and be useful. Separation is putting yourself into a position so you can do what God wants you to do. If all you do is dot every fundamental 'i' and cross every fundamental 't', and you do nothing of a positive nature for Christ, then God calls you a

and you do nothing of a positive nature for Christ, then God calls you a wicked and unprofitable servant.

Ladies who do not wear shorts, pants, mini-skirts, or slits in their dresses can still be considered wicked and unprofitable servants, according to God. Men who do not wear long hair, drink, smoke, go to movies, rent movies, buy movies, or listen to bad music can still be considered wicked and unprofitable servants, according to God. If you never bring a profit to God, then you are a wicked person. Some of the most wicked Christians sit in Bible-believing churches; God says they are wicked because they will stand before God and be judged by their works, and they will stand empty handed. Being an independent, King-James Bible-only, separated, Baptist Christian does not preclude you from being deemed wicked and unprofitable to God.

Separation is not simply getting right with God. It is making yourself available to work with God to cause others to become right with God. Getting right with God is serving God. Separation only puts you in a position to be able to serve Him.
