

FIRST: THE PURPOSE OF MARY.

MATTHEW 1:21

"And she shall being forth a son, and thou shalt call his name Jesus: for he shall save his people from their sins."

I believe that there are several reasons for everyone's life. But I believe that there is but one major purpose.

For instance: I am a son, a father, a husband, a grandfather and a pastor. In each of these areas I know that they are part of God's will for my life, but to put God first in my life is the main purpose. *Matthew 6:33*

In the case of Mary we find that before there was ever a sun, moon, or stars, she was to be born to bring forth a Saviour, Jesus Christ.

Question? Are you fulfilling God's purpose for your life?

SECOND: THE PURITY OF MARY.

ISAIAH 7:14

"Behold, a virgin shall conceive <mark>and bring forth a so</mark>n, and shall call his name Immanuel.

Notice: "A virgin shall conceive." This refers to the purity of this dear, precious woman who was to bring Jesus, the Saviour, into the world.

In *Luke 1* when Zacharias was told of the birth of John the Baptist, he responded in disbelief. When Mary is approached by the angel she did not hesitate, or doubt, but wanted to know how this would come about.

Mary totally lived by faith. She believed God.

- She walked by faith. II Corinthians 5:7
- 2. She was helped by faith. Il Corinthians 1:24
- 3. She overcame by faith, Ephesians 6:16
- 4. She was increased by faith. Romans 10:17

This woman of faith was ready to do the will of God exactly as God gave it. She was totally surrendered without any reservations. *James 4:7*

Oh listen to me!!! No matter how willing she was to be used of God it depended upon her being a virgin.

The virgin birth of Christ was an absolute.

- 1. The virgin birth was to be a sign. Isaiah 7:14
- 2. The virgin birth was to be an act of God. Luke 1:35-37
- 3. The virgin birth was essential to the doctrine of Christ. Isaiah 7:14
- 4. The virgin birth is a must in salvation. *Galatians 4:4-5*

The Miracle Of Christmas





Sweet Potatoe Delight

1/4 cup heavy cream 4 pounds sweet potatoes tablespoons butter, 1/4 cup honey melted 1/3 cup orange juice 1 tsp. orange zest 1 tsp. sea salt 1/4 cup firmly packed dark 1/4 tsp. ground nutmeg brown sugar 3/4 cup pecan halves

Preheat the oven to 350°F.

Peel, wash, and quarter the sweet potatoes. Place them in a stockpot, add enough water to cover them by 2 inches, and bring them to a boil. Continue boiling them until they are fork-tender, about 15 minutes. Drain, and transfer them to a large bowl.

Add the butter, cream, honey, orange juice, orange zest, brown sugar, salt, and nutmeg, and mash everything together with a potato masher or an electric mixer. Spoon the sweet potato mixture into a casserole dish, and top it with pecan halves. Bake it for 30 minutes. Makes 8-10 servings

THIRD: THE PROPHECY FULFILLED BY MARY.

MATTHEW 1:22-23

"Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord by the prophet, saying, Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and bring forth a son..."

This was all about God's way of bringing salvation unto the world by way of the Saviour, God's own Son.

Luke 2:11, "For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord."

Notice: Mary was told five things about the character of the child she would bring into the world.

- 1. He would be called Jesus. Luke 1:31, Jesus means Saviour.
- 2. He would be great. Luke 1:32
 - Great in miracles John 1:50
 - Greater than the temple. *Matthew 12:6-15*
 - Great in His love. John 15:12-14
 - Great in power. I John 4:4
- He would be called the Son of the Highest. Luke 1:32, revealing His relationship to God the Father.
- 4. He would be given the Throne of David. Luke 1:32, II Samuel 7:13-14
- 5. He would reign forever. Luke 1:31

<u>Conclusion:</u> The arrival of Jesus Christ through the yielded life of Mary is the greatest event of all history. It tells us of the Love of God who sent His Son into the world to save wicked mankind.

Have you taken the time and by an act of faith received Jesus Christ, Who is the reason for the season, as your personal Saviour?

I Timothy 1:15, "This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ came into the world to save sinners."

Every time their preacher comes home from a different conference, they find themselves going in a different direction. As a pastor, you should set your face like a flint and provide a solid, fundamental direction for the church you pastor. Preach an unwavering Bible so you can have an unwavering people.

You dear saints of God who have a good, solid man of God, do not run from him when you find yourself disagreeing with him. Sooner or later you will disagree. To follow him when you are in agreement requires no serious commitment. However, to follow him when you find yourself in disagreement will be a test of your character and his character. If you work through your disagreement, both of you will possess greater character.

You loved him—at least that is what you told him when you agreed with him; now you find yourself in disagreement, and so you must leave him? The truth is there is no logic to this decision because, to be an honest person, you will have to leave the next pastor when you and he disagree. And I promise you that you and he will disagree sometime. One day he will rebuke the parents in a sermon, and, if you are an honest person, you will have to leave him just as you left your last pastor who meddled with your parenting. Thus, you will never stop running from church to church. You will be a spiritual failure and a spiritual vagabond.



Lest We Forget

Flying in all kinds of weather, and at night (at the time, no one else flew at night) into the battlefield, rescuing all in need of care - men, women, children, enemy as well as friendly, even a few scout dogs. The Dust Off mission was dedicated to American casualties, but 90% of patients carried under Kelly were Vietnamese.

He became a legend, flying up to 150 hours a month. Entire villages turned out for his pickups, and a Pulitzer Prize-winning writer began covering him. Because our night missions were unprecedented, many thought Dust Off was specially trained for night flying. One commander ordered a staff study of how we did it. The study concluded that night missions were too dangerous. Dust Off overcame these dangers, pioneering night flight and inspiring us, subsequently, to own the night.

On July 1, 1964, Kelly was called into a "secure" area for urgent patients. As he landed, the enemy - often mixed in with friendlies - cut loose. The friendlies screamed at Kelly to get out. He replied calmly in his stubborn southern drawl, "When I have your wounded." He then curled up from a single bullet shot through his heart. He was the 149th American to die in Vietnam. The ship curled with him, and the rotors beat it to pieces.

Vietnamese and American hierarchy alike attended Kelly's funeral. Stilwell wept when told of Kelly's death.

Major Charles Kelly, because of his love for the Vietnamese people, is the only American Army soldier that still has a monument named after him in Vietnam.

New York Court's Polygamy Ruling: Conservatives Were Right About Slippery Slope

Family Research Council President Tony Perkins has denounced a New York judge's ruling that non-monogamous relationships should be treated equally to marriage under the eyes of the law.

Judge Karen May Bardayan of the New York City Civil Court ruled in the case of West 49th St., LLC v. O'Neill that "the time has arrived" for non-monogamous relationships to be given legal recognition...

In a commentary published by the Washington Stand...Perkins said the decision showed that conservatives' claims about a same-sex marriage slippery slope were correct...

Perkins also pointed to a recent Gallup poll that found 23 percent of respondents believed polygamy was "morally acceptable," well above what it was a generation ago.

"And why not? If 'love' and 'consent' are all that define a relationship, then proponents of incest, pedophilia and group marriage can follow the LGBT playbook all the way to validity," Perkins added. "The Left has been quick to say that polygamy isn't the next gay marriage. But who could possibly take them seriously?"

During the debate over same-sex marriage legalization, conservative politicians and activists argued that if same-sex marriage was legalized, polygamy would follow soon after.

In his dissent in the 2015 ruling Obergefell v. Hodges, Chief Justice John Roberts argued that the reasoning behind the majority opinion legalizing gay marriage could be argued in favor of "a fundamental right to plural marriage."
