What To Look For In A Mate

SECOND: SHARED CONVICTIONS.

MARK 3:25.

If you're already miles apart it is very unlikely that you will change a person's life of accumulated ideas.

 - a. Baptist.

- Convictions as to your Christian standards,
 - a. Standards of Dress not indecent.
 - b. Standards of Practice no smoking, drinking.

THIRD: TRUSTED LOVED ONES APPROVAL.

LEVITICUS 19:32

FOURTH: A LOVE FOR THEIR MOTHER.

The First Requirement: Going After Sinners

The first word in the Great Commission, as given in *Mark 16:15*, is "Go." In *Matthew 28:19*, in the Great Commission, Jesus said, "Go ye therefore..."

The Bible command is not, "Build a church house and preach," but "Go...and preach."

Preaching without an earnest effort to reach sinners doesn't fulfill the command of Christ.

Psalm 126:6 puts 'going' first: "He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him." What, use would the weeping be if he didn't go after souls? What use would be the good seed if I didn't go forth and sow it?

Going is the first requirement in soul winning.

We are commanded to "put on the whole armour of God, that [we] may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil" (Eph. 6:11). In that armor, Christians are to put on the girdle of truth, the breastplate of righteousness, to take the shield of faith and the helmet of salvation. But often, we forget the exhortation to have our "feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace" (vs. 15).

What a ridiculous picture to show a man wearing a heavy coat of armor but being barefooted! God wants a Christian to put on the shoes of "the preparation of the gospel of peace."

Lest We Forget



Noor Inayat Khan SOE Operative WWII

"Liberty"

In 1943 Noor was dropped into enemy France and began sending radio messages from around Paris. She proved a good operator in the field and was said to have done her work very skillfully and conscientiously. Unfortunately soon after arriving the 'Prosper' network was broken up by the Gestapo, leaving her as the one remaining



wireless operator. Her superiors in England recommended she return such was the high likelihood of capture. However Noor refused to return, instead playing a vital role as the last remaining wireless operator in Paris. At one

time she was nearly caught when the Gestapo stopped her whilst she was carrying her radio machine. However she was able to bluff her way past saying it was a home cine film projector. Remarkably the Gestapo believed her and for a time she escaped.

However in October Noor was betrayed, possibly by 'Renee'... the wife of her first contact. It was believed Renee sold information to the Gestapo for a small amount of money (1000Fr). A few hours after her arrest Noor attempted an audacious escape across the roof and nearly succeeded but for a British air raid that led to a sudden tightening of security. Thereafter Noor was sent to Germany and kept in shackles in solitary confinement in the civil prison at Pforzhei. Having a strong belief in the truth not once did Noor reveal any information, saying only she was an operative from England. It is said that her tenacity and endurance had an effect even on the hardened prison chiefs of the Gestapo. After enduring 9 months of tortuous imprisonment Noor was transferred with 3 other SOE to the Dachau concentration camp where she was executed with a bullet to the back of her head (just days before Dachau was liberated by the Americans). It is reported her last word before being shot was, "Liberty."

Summer Treat

2 lbs. fresh strawberries, trimmed and sliced

3 to 4 tbsp. sugar, divided

1 tsp. lemon zest

Pinch kosher salt

4 oz. purchased vanilla meringue cookies (such as Trader Joe's)

1 cup heavy cream

1/2 teaspoon vanilla

Place berries in a medium bowl. Sprinkle to 3 tablespoons sugar (use more if berries are slightly underripe, less if they're juicy), the lemon zest and salt. Gently fold with a silicone spatula. Let stand at room temperature 1 hour, folding occasionally.

Meanwhile, break meringues into irregular pieces. (One method: Set each meringue on the countertop and press firmly with the heel of your hand.) You should have about 2 2/3 cups.

Place cream, 1 tablespoon sugar and the vanilla in a mixing bowl. Beat with a mixer on medium speed until stiff peaks form (tips stand straight).

To assemble: Divide half the broken meringues (and their crumbs) among six bowls or good-size (12-ounce) drinking glasses. Top with half of the berries, then half the whipped cream. Repeat layers, ending with cream. Chill 30 to 60 minutes before serving, Makes 6 servings. Prep tip: To serve a party, double the recipe and layer ingredients in a glass trifle bowl.

FEDS SPENT OVER \$1.3B IN RUSSIA, CHINA ON CONTROVERSIAL PROJECTS

The U.S, has sent over \$1.3 billion to China and Russia since 2017, according to a new analysis that details a string of problematic spending projects funded by taxpayers.

The watchdog group. Open the Books, and U.S. Senator Joni Ernst, R-Iowa, released the analysis, which detailed an array of examples they deemed troubling "including \$770,466 to a state-run lab in Russia to put cats on treadmills" and another project for Nearly \$100,000 for gender equality cartoons.

Ernst and Open the Books found at least \$490 million in taxpayer dollars paid to groups in China and another \$870 million paid to organizations in Russia since 2017 via U.S. grants and contracts.

Here is a list of examples:

- \$2.4 million on Russian alcohol and addiction research
- \$2 million to China's state-run Wuhan Institute of Virology to conduct dangerous experiments on bat coronaviruses and transgenic mice.
- \$1.6 million to Chinese companies from National School Lunch Program, which
 means taxpayer dollars from the CARES Act meant for American farmers went to
 Chinese agriculture exporters.
- \$1.45 million for pandemic virus tracking in Russia.
- Subsidies for the Russian space program by funding the Russia Space Agency and vendors.
