Walking In Truth

INTRODUCTION: Before His crucifixion, Jesus was taken to the Judgment Hall where Pilate, the Roman governor, asked Him the question: "What is truth?" (John 18:38). In our Scripture text, we find that Jesus answered that question when He said, "I am... the truth" (John 14:6).

Pastor & Mrs. C "Old-Fashioned Sunday"

FIRST: THE VERY NATURE OF GOD IS TRUTH. JOHN 14:6

A. At least three times in the Bible, the Lord is referred to as the "God of truth" (Deuteronomy 32:4; Psalm 31:5; Isaiah 65:16).

- B. At least three times in the Bible, the Holy Spirit is referred to as, "the Spirit of truth" (John 14:16-17; 15:26; 16:13).
- C. In *I John 5:6*, we read "... the Spirit is truth."
- D. When Jesus said, "I am ... the truth" (John 14:6), as a part of the Trinity, He was claiming equality with God the Father and God the Holy Spirit.
- E. The Apostle Paul re-affirmed this divine characteristic of Christ when he wrote, "... the truth is in Jesus" (Ephesians 4:21).
- F. The Apostle John introduced Jesus as "the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth" (John 1:14).
- G. There is therefore little wonder that God tells us that we, "... must worship him in spirit and in truth " (John 4:23-24).

SECOND: THE WORD OF GOD IS TRUTH.

II TIM. 2:15

- A. Jesus made this clear in one of His last prayers (*John 17:17*).
- B. **Psalm 119** is the longest chapter in the Bible, having 176 verses with nearly every one of them referring to the Word of God in one way or another.
 - 1. Verse 142 says, "... thy law is the truth."
 - 2. In verse 151 we read, "... all thy commandments are truth."
 - Paul told Timothy to study, "... the word of truth" (II Timothy 2:15).
- D. This is why people with great education that do not study the Bible are said to be, "Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth." (II Timothy 3:7).
- E. Again, in chapter four, Timothy was charged to "Preach the word" because people would soon reject it, that is "the word... sound doctrine" or "the truth," and replace it with what they want to hear (II Timothy 4:1-4).

THIRD: THE TRUTH IS THE OPPOSITE OF A LIE.

ROMANS 1:25

- A. Jesus speaks the truth (John 8:39-40).
- B. The Devil speaks lies (John 8:44).
- C. Many people will not listen to, or do not believe "God's words" because the Devil is their father and not God (John 8:45-47).
- D. The Bible says that "... God... cannot lie..." (Titus 1:2), and that it is, "... impossible for God to lie..." (Hebrews 6:18).
- E. Since God is truth and He cannot lie, and since the Devil is a liar, let's observe some of the Lord's attitudes and actions concerning lying.

Matthew 26:48, "Now he that betrayed him gave them a sign, saying, Whomsoever I shall kiss, that same is he: hold him fast."

Thirty years ago, a church member turned on me for the first time. I will never forget the hurt and pain. I had led the man to Christ and baptized him. I had salvaged his marriage; yet he turned on me. Since that time, during thirty-three years of pastoring and thirty-seven years of being a Baptist preacher, a year never went by without someone trying to hurt me or my family. However, I thank God I have not lost faith in humanity.

One of the saddest statements a Christian can make is, "I'll never trust another person as long as I live." When a person is hurt by a preacher, that person usually responds by saying, "I'll never trust another preacher as long as I live." That is a tragic statement for a Christian to make.

I once pastored a man who was as pessimistic a man as I have ever met. He had nothing good to say about anybody or anything. To him the glass was never half full, but always half empty. He trusted no one. One day he asked me what his trouble was, and I told him his real problem was that he did not trust himself.

A Moment For Thought

The Biden administration unveiled a new website [late June] that directs young girls to information about how to get a secret abortion without their parents' knowledge.

Townhall reports the US. Department of Health and Human Services website, Reproductive Rights.gov, provides information about how to get an abortion and how to get others to pay for it now that states may protect unborn babies by banning abortions again.

The website describes killing unborn babies in abortions as a right" even though the U.S. Supreme Court said there is no right to abortion in its historic ruling Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health...

- Defending the "right to life" is not only the Christian way, but it is also the historic (1776-1973), American way.
- 3. We claim the right to speak our piece without being threatened, harassed or otherwise intimidated.
- 4. We maintain our privilege to protest any and all things we believe to be wrong.
- 5. In all things at all times and for all causes we are peace-loving, nonviolent people.
- 6. We respect everyone's life and property and oppose the violent or destructive actions of anybody who gets out of line. Anyone who gets violent or destructive should be arrested and prosecuted.
- 7. For us to remain silent while babies are being butchered is so pagan as to be unthinkable.

- 1. Not only does God "hate "lying, but it is "an abomination unto him" (Proverbs 6:16-19).
- 2. "... Gehazi, the servant of Elisha... "became "... a leper as white as snow " (II Kings 5:20-27).
- 3. God killed "Ananias, with Sapphira his wife" shortly after Pentecost (Acts 5:1-11).
- 4. When the people "... changed the truth of God into a lie... God gave them up... " (Romans 1:25 -26).
- 5. Paul wrote, "...putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbor... " (Ephesians 4:25; see also Ephesians 6:10-14a).
- When the Anti-Christ shall come "... with all... lying wonders... " many shall "perish" and "be damned" (condemned, II Thessalonians 2:8-12).
- 7. No liars will be allowed in Heaven if they do not get saved (*Revelation 21:27*).
- 8. Revelation 21:8 warns us that "... all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone... "if they do not get saved.
- 9. We should have the conviction and prayer of the Psalmist, who cried out, "I hate and abhor lying: but thy law do I love." (Psalm 119:163).

FOURTH: THE TRUTH IS OUR FREEDOM.

JOHN 8:32

- A. Jesus said "the truth" brings freedom (John 8:31-32).
 - 1. We are born again by "the word of truth " (James 1:18), so that is freedom from eternal damnation.
 - 2. "... he that doeth truth... " is not ashamed to stand before God (John 3:21), so that is freedom from a guilty conscience.
 - 3. The Bible says, "... his truth shall be thy shield and buckler. Thou shall not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day;" (Psalm 91:4-5), so that is freedom from fear.
- B. On the other hand, *Proverbs 19:5* says, "... he that speaketh lies shall not escape," indicating that liars do not have freedom; but that they are captured because of their lies.

FIFTH: THE TRUTH MUST BE CHOSEN.

I TIM. 2:4

- A. In Psalm 119:30 we read, "I have chosen the way of truth..."
- B. The Bible says concerning the Lord, "Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth." (I Timothy 2:4)
 - 1. This shows God's invitation to come to the truth and be saved.
 - 2. With every Invitation is the choice to accept the offer or to reject it.

SIXTH: THE CHILD OF GOD'S SERVICE IS TO BE CONTROLLED BY TRUTH. JOSH. 24:14

- A. When Joshua drew that line in the sand so to speak, and gave that famous challenge, "... choose you this day whom ye will serve... but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD" (Joshua 24:15), he also made the statement, "Now therefore fear the LORD, and serve him in sincerity and in truth... "(Joshua 24:14; see also I Samuel 12:24).
- B. If what we say and what we do are not the same, then we are not walking in truth, but we are living a lie (1 John 1;6 & 8; 2;4).
- CONCLUSION:
- 1. Under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, John wrote, "... I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth." (III John 3-4)
- 2. Let's walk in truth seeking to be like Jesus, who said, "I am... the truth."



Duty—Honor—Country. Those three hallowed words reverently dictate what you ought to be, what you can be, what you will be. They are your rallying points to build courage when courage seems to fail, to regain faith when there seems to be little cause for faith, to create hope when hope becomes forlorn. Unhappily, I possess neither that eloquence of diction, that poetry of imagination, nor that brilliance of metaphor to tell you all that they mean

Five Star General Douglas Macarthur

The unbelievers will say they are but words, but a slogan, but a flamboyant phrase. Every pedant, every demagogue, every cynic, every hypocrite, every troublemaker and, I am sorry to say, some others of an entirely different character, will try to downgrade them even to the extent of mockery and ridicule.

You are the leaven which binds together the entire fabric of our national system of defense. From your ranks come the great captains who hold the nation's destiny in their hands the moment the war tocsin sounds. The Long Gray Line has never failed us. Were you to do so, a million ghosts in olive drab, in brown khaki, in blue and gray, would rise from their white crosses thundering those magic words—Duty-Honor—Country.

This does not mean that you are warmongers. On the contrary, the soldier, above all other people, prays for peace; for he must suffer and bear the deepest wounds and scars of war. But always in our ears ring the ominous words of Plato, that wisest of all philosophers, "Only the dead have seen the end of war."

The shadows are lengthening for me. The twilight is here. My days of old have vanished tone and tint; they have gone glimmering through the dreams of things that were. Their memory is one of wondrous beauty, watered by tears and coaxed and caressed by the smiles of yesterday.

I listen vainly, but with thirsty ear, for the witching melody of faint bugles blowing reveille, of far drums beating the long roll. In my dreams I hear again the crash of guns, the rattle of musketry, the strange mournful mutter of the battlefield.

But in the evening of my memory, always I come back to West Point. Always there echoes and re-echoes in my ears—Duty—Honor- Country.

Today marks my final roll call with you. But I want you to know that when I cross the river my last conscious thoughts will be of the Corps—and the Corps—and the Corps.

I bid you farewell.

Conclusion: General Douglas Macarthur was the most decorated soldier of all American history.

Chocolate Cream Cups

3 oz bittersweet chocolate (70% cocoa), broken up

1 tbsp unsalted butter, cut up

1 3/4 cups heavy cream 3 egg volks

1/4 cup sugar

1/4 tsp kosher salt 1/2 tsp vanilla

Sweetened Whipped Cream (below) Chocolate curls, ground cinnamon and/or unsweetened cocoa powder (optional)

- 1. Set six 4-oz ramekins on a rimmed baking sheet or platter. Place chocolate and butter in a 4-cup measuring cup or bowl (preferably one with a spout). Set a fine-mesh sieve over top.
- 2. In a small saucepan, whisk together cream, yolks, sugar and salt. Cook over medium-high, whisking constantly, until cream thickens and bubbles, 6 to 7 minutes.
- 3. Pour hot cream through the sieve, onto the chocolate and butter. Let stand 5 minutes. Using an immersion blender or whisk, blend until completely smooth. Stir in vanilla.
- 4. Pour mixture into ramekins. Let cool on a wire rack until room temperature, about 20 minutes. Cover and refrigerate until completely chilled. (Two hours will do, but overnight deepens the flavors.) Top with Sweetened Whipped Cream and, if desired, chocolate curls, cinnamon and/or cocoa powder, MAKES 6 SERVINGS.

SWEETENED WHIPPED CREAM In a medium bowl, combine 1/2 cup heavy cream, 2 tbsp sugar and 1/2 tsp vanilla. Beat with a mixer on medium-high until soft peaks form, 2 to 2 1/2 minutes.
