Abortion in the Light of Christmas



INTRODUCTION: Life begins at conception, not birth. Yet, there are many lies being promoted to push for acceptance of abortion. Let us examine abortion in light of Christmas. Luke 1:41: "And it came to pass, that, when Elisabeth heard the salvation of Mary, the Babe leaped in her womb..." Examine: Isaiah 49:1, Jeremiah 1:5, and Psalms 139:13-16.

FIRST: THE RIGHT TO CHOOSE.

If every person has a right to choose, then does every teenage boy have a right to rape any girl in his school or neighborhood, if that is his choice? After all, it's his body and neither you nor 1 have the right to tell him what to do with his body based on this reasoning. He is free to choose and it is none of our business what choice he makes... or is it? Excuse me! I don't think so!

People claim that we have no right to impose our morals upon him. Whether I like the choice or not, he should have the freedom of choice IF we believe the logic of "choice." But you (and I) would say, "The response to this kind of thing would mean that the rape of an innocent teenage girl would ignore her rights! EXACTLY! This is what abortion does to babies. Abortion violates the rights of the little baby that cannot defend itself. Most of America is not pro-choice when it comes to murder, rape, kidnapping, armed robbery, and child abuse, we are not opposing something that is right, but something that is very wrong. To be "pro-choice" about someone's right to kill is to be anti-choice about someone else's right to live.

SECOND: THE RIGHT OF PRIVACY.

Did you know there is nothing constitutional about the right to privacy, because the right is nowhere found in the Constitution of the United States. It was declared by the Supreme Court in 1973, as a right higher that an unborn child's right to live. Is privacy a right? Yes, but society recognizes that some rights are higher than others. No Place For Jesus Luke 2:7

It had been prophesied that Jesus would be born in Bethlehem. This world was not prepared for the birth of Christ. It had been prophesied that the Messiah would come. Jesus was going to come. This shows Christs willingness to humble Himself, His willingness to be that servant, to do for us what only He can do. It also shows that this world would reject Him. not only then in the manger but also one day on the cross. I think what might be just as tragic, or more tragic today, is that man says, "God, I do not have any room for You. Jesus, I do not have a place for You, but I will give You what I have left over.

Lest We Forget



1st Lt. Larry Taylor

A graduate of the University of Tennessee, Knoxville, Larry Taylor was commissioned as a second lieutenant in the Army Reserve in 1966. He completed the armor officers basic course at Fort Knox, KY, before deciding he'd rather fly. Taylor qualified as an aviator in 1967 and was assigned to one of the first Cobra companies in Vietnam.

Serving with D Troop, 1st Squadron, 4th Cavalry, 1st

Infantry Division, Taylor flew over 2,000 combat missions in UH-1 and Cobra helicopters. According to the Army, his decorations include 43 Air

Medals, a Bronze Star, two Distinguished Flying Crosses and the Congressional Medal of Honor.

The teacher asked "What counsel are you going to give this mother?" One student gave what seemed was the obvious answer to them: "I would tell the mother to get an abortion." The teacher responded, "Congratulations... you have just killed Beethoven"

FOURTH: WHAT ABOUT RAPE?

Rape is not a key factor for pregnancy in the abortion debate. Fearful young women will sometimes attribute their pregnancies to rape to gain sympathy and avoid the condemnation of immoral behavior. A young woman called "Roe" in the Roe vs. Wade case elicited sympathy in court and in the media by claiming to be raped. In the May 9, 1989, issue of the Oregonian, she admitted she lied and was never raped at all. Killing the baby in a rape case doesn't solve or cure the problem. Why should you kill the innocent third party? Why should you punish the child for what the father did?

FIFTH: ABORTION ADVANCES THE ROLE OF WOMEN.

If you ask me, killing babies to advance your cause is no advancement at all. Did you know that early feminists were pro-life, not pro-choice? Susan B. Anthony stood for women when they were not allowed to vote. She referred to abortion as "child murder" and a horrible crime. Alice Paul drafted the original version of the Equal Rights Amendment. She also referred to abortion as the "ultimate exploitation of women" (June 24,1991, Christianity Today), The hypocrisy or irony of pro-choice feminists is the fact they defend a belief which is killing females across the globe by the millions.

SIXTH: THE UNWANTED CHILD.

People, there is no such creature as an unwanted child. The demand for babies is so great that a Black Market had developed where babies are sold for as much as \$35,000. Not only a normal baby is desired, children with Down Syndrome are desired too. An unwanted baby is a myth. Adoption agencies have a seven-year waiting list with one and a half million families wanting to adopt. The problem is not children who are unwanted, but un-wanting adults.

SEVENTH: ABORTION REDUCES CHILD ABUSE.

Legalized abortion has not reduced child abuse. Reports of child abuse and neglect in the United States have more than tripled since the legalization of abortion in 1973, and those stats are continuing to escalate. There were 669,000 abuse and neglect case in 1976. In 1986, it jumped to 2.1 million cases according to the National Center on Child Abuse and Neglect. The American Human Society reports that in 2005 it has jumped to 3.3 million cases of abuse or neglect. Abortion cheapens life and a concern for the living.

CONCLUSION: Abortion is wrong. Stop believing whatever new philosophy that some modern, spoiled, or so-called educated person tries to shove at you through the media. Study it through yourself.

From our Pastor's Wife... Mrs. Vida Collingsworth



The Difference One Can Make

Although the apathy of some Christians and the wickedness of society are discouraging, we should pray and remain confident. William Wilberforce was a great Christian philanthropist and vigorous opponent of the slave trade in England during the early 1800s. As he surveyed the terrible moral and spiritual climate of his day, he did not lose hope. He wrote, "My own solid hopes for the well-being of my country depend, not so much on her navies or armies, nor on the wisdom of her rulers, nor on the spirit of her people, as on the persuasion that she still contains many who love and obey the Gospel of Christ. I believe that their prayers may yet prevail." Within a few years after he made that statement, the country he loved experienced one of the greatest revivals in modern times, bringing salvation to thousands and producing widespread social changes.

Sweet Potatoe Cake

1 tsp. ground cinnamon 1/2 tsp. baking soda

1/4 tsp. salt

1/4 tsp. ground nutmeg

2 cups cold mashed sweet

potatoes

1 cup butter, softened 2 cups sugar 4 eggs

1 tsp. vanilla extract 3 cups all-purpose flour

2 tsp. baking powder

In a large mixing bowl, cream butter and sugar until light and fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Beat in vanilla. Combine the flour, baking powder, cinnamon, baking soda, salt and nutmeg; add to creamed mixture alternately with sweet potatoes. Beat just until combined (batter will be stiff).

Pour into a greased and floured 10-in. fluted tube pan. Bake at 350 for 50-60 minutes or until a toothpick inserted near the center comes out clean. Cool for 10 minutes before removing from pan to a wire rack to cool completely.

For glaze, in a small bowl, combine the confectioners1 sugar, orange peel and enough juice to achieve desired consistency. Drizzle over cake. Yield: 12 servings.

INDIANA SCHOOL DISTRICT FIGHTS BACK AFTER COURT BLOCKS RULE SEPARATING BATHROOMS BY BIOLOGICAL SEX

Indiana Attorney General Todd Rokita has come out in support of a school district that wants to maintain bathrooms based on biological sex.

Metropolitan School District of Martinsville filed an appeal asking the Supreme Court to "preserve the autonomy of school boards to make decisions" after the Seventh Circuit affirmed a lower court's ruling imposing a restraining order on the district.
