FIRST. THE PREPARATION FOR MARRIAGE.

MATTHEW 6:33

- A. Prepare mentally. Maturity is a must. A marriage is not on a trial basis (*Mark 10:9*). Not only do you make the vows to each other, you make them to God. He will hold you responsible.
- B. Prepare spiritually (*Amos 3:3*). Both people should be of the same faith.
- C. Prepare financially (I Timothy 5:8). It's a shame and a sin to marry and bring children that you cannot support into this world.

Illustration: I have known young people that have decided to get married with getting counsel one time, or reading so much as one book on how to have a good marriage. That is insane!

SECOND. THE PLAN FOR MARRIAGE.

MATTHEW 19:5

- A. Sharing (*Genesis 2:18-23*). Man could not live alone so God created a woman. Marriage brings two people together and makes them one!
- B. Surrender (Genesis 2:24). Both husband and wife work as a team. "Me," "mine," and "my" become "ours."
- C. Submission (*Ephesians 5:22-24*). Wives should submit to their husbands.
- D. Showing (*Ephesians 5:25-32*). Love your wife as you love yourself. The wife should respect the husband.

THIRD. THE PRACTICE IN MARRIAGE.

EPHESIANS 5:25

- A. Control (I Corinthians 13:5). Real love will overlook mistakes and failures.
- B. Co-operation (*Amos 3:3*). The husband and wife must agree and work together. They should sit down and discuss differences without anger.
- C. Character (*Ephesians 5:23*). The husband is the head of the house. To be an effective leader the husband needs wisdom from God.
- D. Conflicts. Talk things over. Learn to "give and take."

FOURTH. THE PROBLEMS IN MARRIAGE.

EPHESIANS 5:33

- A. The Attitudes.
 - Lack of love.
 - Lack of trust
 - 3. Lack of respect, and
- 4. Lack of understanding will cause problems in marriage.
- B. The Adultery
 - 1. Start—begins with lust (*Matthew 5:27-28*). Adultery begins in the heart.



Sweet Potato Delight

6 small sweet potatoes, 2 to 3 tbsp. Cajun seasoning 2 tsp. chili powder or chili peeled 1 cup mayonnaise garlic sauce

2 tsp. Dijon mustard 2 tbsp. olive oil 4 tsp. lemon juice

Cut each sweet potato lengthwise into eight wedges; place in two greased 15-in. x 10-in. x 1-in. baking pans. Drizzle with oil. Sprinkle with Cajun seasoning; toss to coat.

Bake at 400° for 30-35 minutes or until tender, turning once. Meanwhile, in a small bowl, combine the remaining ingredients; serve with potatoes. Yield: 8 servings.

The Conversion of Mary Magdalene Luke 8:1-2

"And it came to pass afterward, that he went throughout every city and village, preaching and shewing the glad tidings of the kingdom of God: and the twelve were with him, And certain women, which had been healed of evil spirits and infirmities, Mary called Magdalene, out of whom went seven devils."
