I am a happy person. In order, these are the four things on which I spend the most time in prayer:

1. The power of the Holy Spirit: I have two things that I have prayed for myself in the last twenty-five years. One thing was the wedding [vow renewal ceremony] I got on my fiftieth wedding anniversary. I prayed for it, and I got it. Apart from that, there was only one other thing for which have prayed. I pray for the power of God. Blessed are the beggars for the spirit; blessed are the beggars for the spirit. That is one reason why I am happy. I am happier than the folks who write articles on how to be happy.

2. I yield myself to the Holy Spirit and ask Him to help me cross the paths of those who Jesus would help if He were in my shoes.

3. **I ask the Lord to help me to be a blessing.** Every day I pray for the meeting where I will be five weeks from that day. I pray for five weeks for every out-of-town meeting where I will speak.

4. I ask God to help me find out the needs of the people at First Baptist Church and to be what they need me to be as their preacher. I never have asked anyone to pray for anything that I wanted. At one time, I was driving an old Plymouth. One day while driving, I looked down and saw the pavement through the floorboard. Just as you would say, "Lord, give me some food," I simply said, "Lord, give me a new car." That is all I said. I did not ask for it twice. When I got home from the meeting, I had a long-distance call from another state. He said, "Dr. Hyles, I am a car dealer. God spoke to my heart and told me to give you a new car. I will pay for your plane ticket to come and drive the new car back."

Truth John 8:32

First: Jesus Is Truth. To know Jesus is to know the truth. Many people do not know the truth about Jesus; therefore, they cannot find their way to God. Cults often will use the name of Jesus, but they deny the truth about Him. We cannot separate truth from Christ lest we pervert the Gospel. "Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth." (I Timothy 2:4)

"That they an might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness." (II Thessalonians 2: 12)

Second: We Are Sanctified Through Truth. We read in John 17:17, "Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth." The truth by which we are sanctified

is God's Word. There cannot be sanctification without truth. Sanctification is the purification of a believer. To be sanctified is to be set apart or made holy and sacred. Many Christians have abandoned separation because they are walking by their feelings rather than in truth. Sanctification cleanses us from corruption, purifies us from sin, detaches us from the affections of the world, and leads us to love God so that we may honor Him with our lives.

Third: We are set free by truth. In John 8:32, we read, "And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." We are free only when we make truth the basis of our faith. Many Christians live in the bondage of sin because they are following their feelings rather than girding up their loins with truth.

<u>Fourth: The Lord Draws Nigh To Those Who Pray In Truth.</u> Today, there are many false notions being taught about prayer. Contemplative prayer, which is a new age version of meditation, is becoming more popular today and is an example of prayer without truth. Those who follow it are following error. It sounds good, but it is not truth. God hears us when our relationship with Him is built upon truth. "The LORD is nigh unto all them that call upon him, to all that call upon him in truth." (Psalm 145: 18)

Conclusion: What are you doing with the truth?

B. Reserve the ungodly. *II Peter 2:9*

<u>CONCLUSION</u>: If you were to take inventory today, could you firmly acknowledge that you are still sound as the day you made the decision concerning that particular service? Are you sound about the Word of God, church, family, education; your home in Heaven?

Whose in the Driver's Seat?

Proverbs 3:5-7, "Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths. Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil."

Have you ever been driving only to find yourself in the wrong lane and then you have passed your destination and you have to turn around and come back.

Often times when you use your GPS you may not be paying close attention or the GPS takes you in a direction you don't want to go. So you go your own way waiting for it to recalculate.

Each day, we as Christians, should desire to let the Lord direct our life, our thoughts, our words, our actions, our appearance, and our attitude. The keyword to doing this is yieldedness. The yield signs on the road are there for a reason. Our lack of yielding can most definitely cause disaster, injury, or even death. So we must carefully look before proceeding into traffic.

This applies to us as Christians. We awaken for the day but we must seek the Lord's direction and help in our day. If we are truly yielded we will pay more attention to what's around us. Then we know whatever happens in our day, God has allowed for a purpose.

But oftentimes we start off wanting to yield to the Lord only to have disruptions or distractions in our day and then we find ourselves taking over and taking control! No thought for prayer and God's direction.

Most women want to be fixers. We remember the verse in Ecclesiastes 9:10 that says, "Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do do it with all thy might...", but the rest of that verse lets us know that once we die there's no more opportunity to do what we could so we truly need to be women led by the Holy Spirit, giving every effort to do what the Lord directs us to do.

The Key To Revival II Chronicles 7:14

Revival begins with a burden. In Bible Christianity, a burden is not negative, but positive. It is not something to be avoided, but something to be desired. We are slow to see this because we are not alert spiritually, and we fail to understand what God has said. For example, here is the Apostle Paul with a burden, a great burden, and yet a victorious Christian. Yet he said, "I am troubled. I am distressed about things, I am so burdened about the people of Israel." He said, "I have great heaviness and continual sorrow in my heart. For I could wish that myself were accursed [separated] from Christ..." if it could bring his people to the Saviour. He was burdened.

The Lord Jesus Christ was the same way, and we have it here in Matthew 23:37. He was so burdened, so concerned. Every step that Jesus took indicated His burden and concern for others. The attitude of our Saviour was serious. We have today in the thinking of our Lord of this time a matter of tears. In his hour sometimes there is a laxness, a turning away from the things of God. But not with the Lord Jesus Christ. It was a matter of deep concern for others. He cried over Jerusalem.

The thing missing in most of our churches is a burden. The flesh reacts against assuming a burden for others. We have faith in Christ. We believe in Him. We believe in the indwelling Holy Spirit. We accept the Bible as God's Holy Word. We believe in the New Testament church, the ordinances of baptism and the Lord's Supper. We believe in the importance of worship. We believe in missions, and the giving to missions. But, we lack the burden: a burden for souls, a burden for others, a burden for the salvation of lost people.

The key to revival is a burden, and when you talk about Christ, the Master Key, you have to face this. You have to face what Jesus said as He looked upon the city of Jerusalem. So. we pray tonight, "O God, stir our hearts."
