Misunderstood Christmas



INTRODUCTION: The world turns once a year to the story of Christmas, but to the Christian it is a 52-weeks-a-year truth. Satan loves to get his points in during the Christmas season and leave mistaken impressions in the mind of the world. Let us notice a few of these misunderstandings.

FIRST: WAS JESUS BORN IN BETHLEHEM?

MICAH 5:2

We could never teach this enough. Let us impress upon the minds of every reader that Jesus came to earth in Bethlehem, but He is the eternal Son of God.

- 1. He was in the beginning. John 1:1a.
- 2. He was with God. John 1:1b.
- 3. He was God. John 1:1c. Also read Isaiah 9:6.
- 4. He became fashioned as a man. Philippians 2:8.
- 5. He simply "camped out on earth" for 33 years, John 1:14. The world "dwell' here mean: "tabernacled." You will also find reference to His preexistence in Genesis 3:8; Daniel 3:25; John 1:3; John 17:5; and Revelation 1:17.

SECOND: WAS JOSEPH JESUS FATHER?

<u>I TIMOTHY 3:16</u>

The devil enjoys hearing parents tell their children that Joseph was the father of Jesus. He is never spoken of as such in the Bible. The Holy Spirit is very careful to use every word properly in showing us this truth.

- 1. <u>Joseph was not told Jesus would be his son.</u> *Matthew 1:21*. You will notice that the Holy Spirit says to Joseph when announcing the coming of the Christ Child that Mary should bring forth "a" son, not "your" son.
- Joseph was not referred to as Jesus' father. Luke 2:33. You will notice it says, "And Joseph and his mother marvelled at those things which were spoken of him." It did not say, "His father and His mother."
- 3. <u>Jesus spoke of God as His Father.</u> Notice Jesus said, "I must be about my Father's business." Joseph was looking for Jesus, and Jesus was very careful to remind Joseph that He must be about "His" Father's business. God was His Father. Joseph was one of the best men in the Bible, and yet he was definitely not the father of Christ.
- Joseph was involved so that Jesus would have legal right to the throne of David. Luke 1:32,33. The genealogy of Jesus in Matthew 1:1-16 traces the line of Joseph. The genealogy of Mary is in Luke 3:23-38.

THIRD: WHAT ABOUT THE VIRGIN BIRTH?

SAIAH 7:14

Perhaps no doctrine is attacked more by religious people than the doctrine of the virgin birth of Christ. He was born of a virgin. Let us notice the Scriptural teaching of this matter.

- 1. It was prophesied that He would he born of a virgin, *Isaiah* 7:14.
- 2. The Bible plainly says that Joseph was not the father of Christ. Matthew 1:18. Mary and Joseph had not yet become husband and wife.
- 3. At first Joseph did not even understand and felt that Mary had been unfaithful to him. Matthew 1:19.

Toppings: Guacamole, Salsa, Sour cream, Pico de gallo, Cilantro leaves, Lime wedges

2 tbsp. olive oil 1 tbsp. chili powder 1 tbsp. ground cumin 1 tsp. garlic powder 1 tsp. smoked paprika 3/4 tsp. kosher salt

Nonstick cooking spray 1.5 lb. boneless, skinless chicken breasts, cut into ½-inch-thick strips, or chicken tenderloins 1 medium white onion. halved and sliced

Chicken Fajitas Tacos

1 medium red bell pepper, 16 6 inch corn or flour 1/8 tsp. cayenne pepper cut into 1/4-inch strips

1 medium yellow bell pepper, cut into 1/4-inch strips

1 large or 2 medium poblano chiles, cut into thin strips tortillas, warmed

Preheat oven to 425°F. Line a 18x13-inch (half-sheet) baking pan with parchment paper or foil. (Lightly coat foil with cooking spray.)

Stir together chili powder, cumin, garlic powder, paprika, salt and cayenne pepper in a large bowl. Add chicken, onion, bell peppers, and poblano; toss to coat. Spread chicken mixture evenly in pan. Roast 20 to 25 minutes or until chicken is done (165°F) and vegetables are tender, stirring once halfway through cooking.

Spoon chicken mixture into warm tortillas and add desired toppings. Serve with lime wedges.

THE REASON FOR THE SEASON

Luke 2:8-17

In Luke chapter 2, we read of the birth of Christ and we find in this story many wonderful things, but this season I want to discuss the shepherds in field. Many over look them, and that is understandable, but there is a wonderful story to be told and an example to follow.

In these short few verses we read of shepherds who were where they needed to be when they needed to be there. If the shepherds had not been faithful that night to be in the field with the sheep they would have missed the proclamation from the angels, they would have missed the opportunity to see Jesus in a manger.

They probably would have even missed their opportunity to be listed in the scriptures.

We also read of shepherds who would investigate the truth. We see that shepherds were told of Jesus in a manger, but like most today they did not say they were too busy to investigate. These shepherds stopped what they were doing and went and saw where Jesus laid in a manger.

We also read that the shepherds did the most important thing that night. They took the message of Christ's birth and proclaimed it abroad. They did not hold these truths in their hearts, but shared it with others. They were responsible for starting the fire that proclaimed the birth of Christ.

Will you be faithful like the shepherds this Christmas season? Will you make sure it is Christ's birth that is proclaimed? Will you help others understand that Jesus is the Reason for the Season?

- The angel told us of the virgin birth. Matthew 1:20. The angel clearly stated that the Holy Ghost, not Joseph, is the Father of Jesus.
- 5. The word "Emmanuel" here perhaps wraps the Christmas story up in three words better than any other words. *Matthew 1:23*. It simply means "God with us." Again the virgin birth is taught.

FOURTH: IS MARY THE MOTHER OF GOD?

SAIAH 9

Not a better lady can be found in the Bible perhaps than Mary. To be sure she was a very clean, virtuous lady and deserves much credit. However, she is never called "the mother of God."

- 1. She knew the Saviour. Luke 1:47. This means that she too was a sinner.
- 2. She was a woman of low estate, not of high estate. Luke 1:48.
- 3. John 2:4 explains Jesus' feeling toward the matter.
- 4. Mary was not the only woman called "blessed among women." Judges 5:24. It is interesting how tradition slips into Christianity.

CONCLUSION: Nothing is more important to stress than that Jesus is the preexistent Son of God. He was not the son of Joseph; He did not just come into existence in Bethlehem; He was born of a virgin; and Mary was simply the instrument used to bring His body into the world. He is the Saviour.



CCP FRONT GROUPS OPERATING ALL ACROSS AMERICA

ILLINOIS MANDATES 'MENTAL HEALTH' TESTING FOR ALL STUDENTS

Children's minds are now officially in the crosshairs of one of the most out-of-control state governments in America. Under a controversial new measure just signed into law by far-left Governor J. B. Pritzker, government schools in Illinois will begin mandatory "mental health" testing of all students each year, starting in third grade.

Critics are sounding the alarm. Among other concerns, they are warning that Big Brother cannot be trusted to pry into the minds of children. From education leaders and privacy advocates to psychiatrists and medical professionals, opponents of the plan say it will intrude into the most sensitive areas of a child's life.

While Illinois is the first state to do it with SB 1560, Big Pharma lobbyists hoping to profit from drugging children are working overtime to get similar schemes passed in other jurisdictions.

Harvard-trained psychiatrist Dr. Peter Breggin, celebrated worldwide for his war on quackery such as lobotomies and electro-shock "therapy," sounded the alarm about the Illinois plan as well. Among other concerns, he blasted the collaboration between Big Pharma and organized psychiatry to invade schools and "make a market out of children."

Lest We Forget



Frank Currey

Frank Curry's Medal of Honor Citation reads as follows:

The President of the United States of America, in the name of Congress, takes pleasure in presenting the Medal of Honor to Private Francis Sherman "Frank" Currey, United States Army, for conspicuous gallantry and intrepidity in action above and beyond the call of duty. Private Currey was an automatic rifleman with above and Platoon, Company K, 3d Battalion, 120th Infantry, 30th Infantry Division, defending a strong point near Malmedy, Belgium, on 21 December 1944, when the enemy launched a powerful attack. Overrunning tank destroyers and antitank guns located near the strong point, German tanks advanced to the 3rd Platoon's position,

and, after prolonged fighting, forced the withdrawal of this group to a nearby factory. Sergeant Currey found a bazooka in the building and crossed the street to secure rockets meanwhile enduring intense fire from enemy tanks and hostile infantrymen who had taken up a position at a house a short distance away. In the face of small-arms, machinegun, and artillery fire, he, with a companion, knocked out a tank with one shot. Moving to another position, he observed three Germans in the doorway of an enemy-held house. He killed or wounded all three with his automatic rifle. He emerged from cover and advanced alone to within 50 yards of the house, intent on wrecking it with rockets. Covered by friendly fire, he stood erect, and fired a shot which knocked down half of one wall. While in this forward position, he observed five Americans who had been pinned down for hours by fire from the house and three tanks. Realizing that they could not escape until the enemy tank and infantry guns had been silenced, Sergeant Currey crossed the street to a vehicle, where he procured an armful of antitank grenades. These he launched while under heavy enemy fire, driving the tankmen from the vehicles into the house. He then climbed onto a half-track in full view of the Germans and fired a machinegun at the house. Once again changing his position, he manned another machinegun whose crew had been killed; under his covering fire the five soldiers were able to retire to safety. Deprived of tanks and with heavy infantry casualties, the enemy was forced to withdraw. Through his extensive knowledge of weapons and by his heroic and repeated braving of murderous enemy fire, Sergeant Currey was greatly responsible for inflicting heavy losses in men and material on the enemy, for rescuing five comrades, two of whom were wounded, and for stemming an attack which threatened to flank his battalion's position.

According to a US Army Press Release dated 1945 Curry is quoted as saying "I wanted to stick right through with the fellows. Now that I'm setting foot on American soil again it's going to be a pleasure to get out. I've had all the fighting I want, and I'm lucky to be able to talk to you." Sergeant Currey completes his Army career in "Grand Slam" fashion. He was awarded just about everything there was to be awarded. Besides the Medal of Honor, he was awarded the Silver Star, the Bronze Star, the Purple Heart, and the Certificate of Merit, and his outfit earned a unit citation, giving him the right to wear the Distinguished Unit Badge. He also wears three battle stars.
